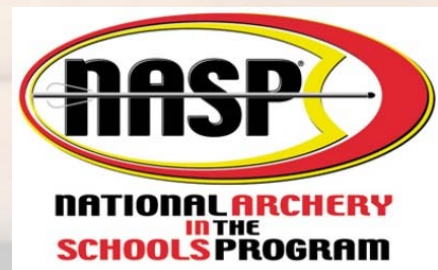
Discover the fun and safe world of archery and truly change your students' lives!
