

Administrative Directive W-21

Addendum 1, dated 1 January 2008

Purpose: To add administrative requirements for requesting turkey licenses under the Youth Outreach Program Hunting Licenses authority defined in this Administrative Directive.

Changes:

Paragraph IV(A) Change first sentence to read: **“The Colorado Division of Wildlife is committed to expanding the opportunity for youth to participate in big game and turkey hunting activities.”**

Paragraph IV (B) (3) Youth hunter. Add last sentence to read: **“Youth hunters requesting a turkey license must comply with all age and Hunter Education requirements established in the current Division of Wildlife Turkey Hunting Brochure.”**

Paragraph V (A) 1. Add last sentence to read: **“The age requirements for youth hunters is established in the current Turkey Hunting brochure.”**

Paragraph V(A)5a. Change to read: **“Licenses in big game management units with at least one hunt code requiring 10 or more resident preference points to draw, excluding Ranching for Wildlife properties, will not be authorized under this program. Youth Outreach Turkey Licenses will be used on Private Lands Only. Licenses in game management units with at least one hunt code requiring four (4) or more resident preference points to draw, excluding Ranching for Wildlife properties, will not be authorized for use under this program. Licenses are NOT VALID on any State Wildlife Area.”**
