TO BE CONSIDERED AS A RECORD FISH BY WEIGHT FOR COLORADO IN ANY OF THE ABOVE CATEGORIES:

- 1 Angler must have a valid Colorado Fishing License
- 2 Fish must be taken by legal angling from Colorado waters.
- 3 Fish may have been caught in either public or private fishing waters.
- 4 An official entry form must be used. Photograph of fish and length, weight, and girth measurements must accompany entry. Weight should be taken before fish is frozen and on a scale which has been certified by the State of Colorado to be accurate to one ounce (meat market, produce, grocery scales).
- 5 Entry must be accompanied by signature of one person (not relatives) who witnessed weighing and measuring. After weighing, the fish may be iced, but not frozen, filleted or otherwise cut up. It must be available for inspection and identification by Division personnel before being frozen and before an entry form is submitted.
