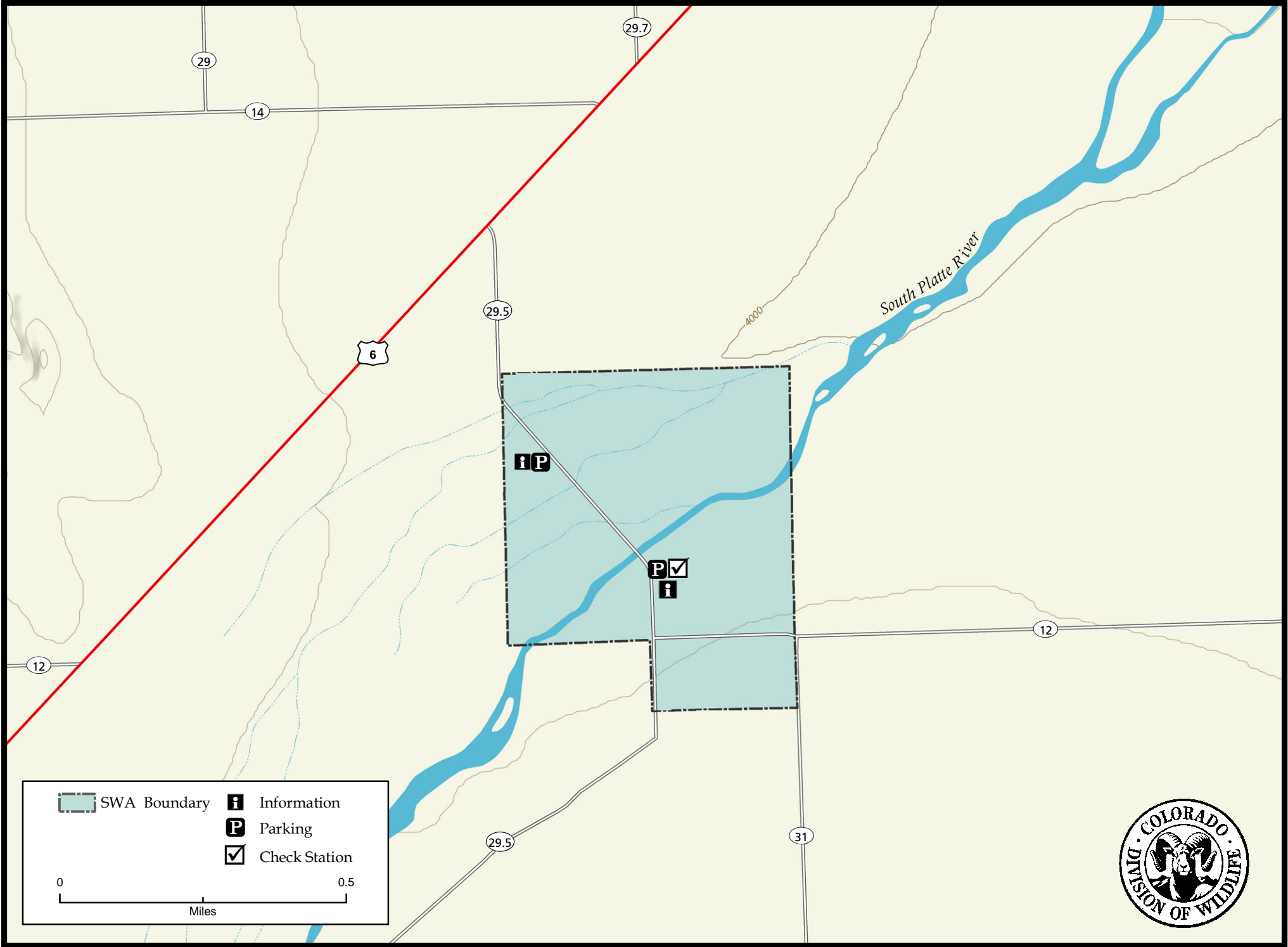






# Atwood State Wildlife Area

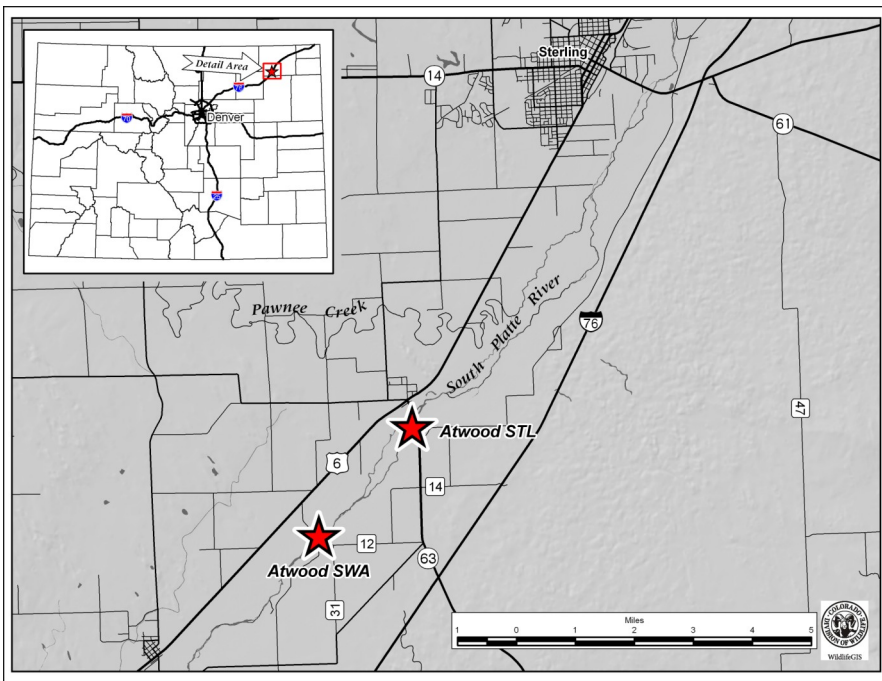

## Atwood State Wildlife Area & Atwood State Trust Land Logan County



**Atwood SWA:** From Interstate 76 at the Atwood exit (Exit 115), go 3/4 mile north on Highway 63 to County Road 12 and then west (left). Go 1 3/4 miles west to CR 29.5 and then north (right).

**Atwood STL:** From Interstate 76 at the Atwood exit (Exit 115), go 2 1/2 miles north on Highway 63. Access is on the west side of Hwy 63 for the main portion. For the Youth portion, turn right (east) on County Road 16; parking lot is 1/4 mile on the left.

**#901.A:** On those properties requiring reservations, reservations may be made by calling 1-800-846-9453. Reservations are not accepted more than 14 days in advance of the hunt date, nor after 12:00 noon on the day before the hunt date, or Friday at 12:00 noon for Sundays and holidays falling on Monday. Hunters who wish to cancel a reservation must do so no later than 12:00 noon on the day before the hunt date. Failure to hunt a reserved area without prior cancellation, or follow check station procedures, may cause forfeiture of the privilege to make reservations for the remainder of the hunting season. Hunters are limited to a maximum of one reservation per hunt date and one reservation per phone call. Reservations are not transferable. The individual named on the reservation must be at the property on the day of the hunt and be a licensed hunter for the species to be hunted.

### Regulations – Atwood SWA:

- A. Access allowed only through designated parking area.
- B. Public access is restricted to foot traffic only.
- C. Access is limited to four (4) groups or vehicles with a maximum number of four (4) people per group.
- D. From June 1 through August 31, access is limited to wildlife observation only, and only on Saturday, Sunday, and Wednesday.
- E. From September 1 through May 31, hunting is permitted only on Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday, legal holidays, and the opening day of the late rifle deer season. All recreational activities, except deer hunting, are prohibited on the opening weekend of the regular plains rifle deer season and on the opening day and first weekend of the late plains rifle deer season.
- F. Turkey hunting is permitted on opening day, Saturday, Sunday, and Wednesday of the turkey seasons.
- G. Fires are prohibited.
- H. Camping is prohibited.
- I. Discharge of bows and firearms is prohibited, except while hunting or for target practice. Target practice is allowed only when authorized by the area wildlife manager.
- J. Discharge of bows is allowed for bowfishing.
- K. Dog training is prohibited.
- L. Horse use is prohibited.
- M. The launching or takeout of vessels is prohibited from the first day of the September teal season until the last day of the dark goose season.
- N. Beginning with the first day of the regular duck season through the last day of the regular duck season the following regulations apply:
  1. Hunting on this property is by reservation only. Reservations may be made in accordance with #901.A of these regulations. Hunters with reservations may only hunt the hunt area speci-

fied on the reservation. Hunters must follow check in and check-out procedures as posted at the property.

2. All waterfowl and small game hunters must check out at the designated check station before leaving the property. Deer and turkey hunters do not need to check out at the check station, but a reservation is required.
3. No more than four people per reservation
4. Waterfowl and small game hunting is permitted only on Saturdays, Sundays, Wednesdays, Columbus Day (observed), Veterans' Day (observed), Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
5. Waterfowl and small game hunters must check out at the check station by 2:00 p.m. daily.
6. All uses other than hunting are prohibited

### Regulations – Atwood STL:

- A. Public access is prohibited from June 1 through August 31.
- B. Hunting is prohibited, except on Saturdays, Sundays, Wednesdays, Labor Day, Columbus Day (observed), Veteran's Day (observed), Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day and Presidents' Day.
- C. Reservations are limited to four (4), two (2) for general reservations, one (1) for hunters with mobility impairments and one (1) for youth mentor. Area for general reservations and hunters with mobility impairments is located on up river side of Hwy 63. Youth mentor is located on down river side of Hwy 63.
- D. Hunting is prohibited with centerfire rifles.
- E. All recreational activities, except deer hunting, are prohibited on the opening weekend of the regular plains rifle deer season and on the opening day and first weekend of the late plains rifle deer season.
- F. Horse use is prohibited, except when used in direct association with training of hunting dogs, and then only permitted in February, March and April (through the Wednesday immediately preceding the opening of the spring turkey season).
- G. The launching or takeout of vessels is prohibited from the first day of the September teal season until the last day of the dark goose season.
- H. All small game and waterfowl hunting is regulated by a reservation system and through a mandatory check station. Reservations may be made in accordance with #901.A of these regulations. Hunters may only hunt the hunt area specified on the reservation. Hunters must follow check in and check out procedures as posted.
