



Brush SWA Morgan County

From Brush, go 2 1/2 miles north on Highway 71, then bear left on County Road 28 for 1 mile to the south parking area. Another parking area is located on the north side of the river on County Roads T.9 and 27.

Wildlife Area Offers:

Hunting: Deer, Rabbit, Squirrel, Pheasant, Turkey, Bobwhite Quail, Dove, Waterfowl
(GMU 96)

Fishing: Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Bluegills and Trout on Chartier Ponds

Recreation: Wildlife Viewing, Hiking

Regulations:

- A. Camping is prohibited.
- B. Fires are prohibited.
- C. Public access is prohibited from 9:00 pm to 3:00 am daily, except when authorized by a night hunting permit.
- D. Discharge of firearms or bows is prohibited, except when hunting.
- E. Discharge of bows is allowed for bowfishing.
- F. Target practice is prohibited, except when authorized by the area wildlife manager.
- G. All recreational activities, except deer hunting, are prohibited on the opening weekend of regular plains rifle deer season and on the opening day and first weekend of the late plains rifle deer season.
- H. Horse use is prohibited, except when used in direct association with training of hunting dogs, and then only permitted in February, March, April (through the Wednesday immediately preceding the opening of the spring turkey season) and August.
- I. Beginning with the first day of the regular duck season through the last day of the regular duck season, all waterfowl and small game hunters must check out at the designated check station before leaving the property.
- J. All access must be from designated parking areas only.
- K. The launching or takeout of vessels is prohibited from the first day of the September teal season until the last day of the dark goose season.
- L. Beginning with the first day of the regular duck season through the last day of the regular duck season the following regulations apply.
 1. All waterfowl and small game hunting on Brush State Wildlife Area is regulated by a reservation

system and through a mandatory check station. During this period all hunting is by reservation only. Reservations may be made by calling 1-800-846-9553. Hunters must follow check-out procedures as posted at the property. Reservations will be limited as follows: Main (south) parking lot, one waterfowl and one small game reservation per day; Northwest parking lot, one waterfowl and one small game reservation per day; Northeast parking lot (off Highway 71), one youth/mentor waterfowl reservation per day (no more than two mentors and at least one youth per reservation).

2. No more than four people per reservation.
3. Mentors must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid hunter education certificate. Mentors are not required to hunt.
4. Waterfowl and small game hunting is permitted only on Saturdays, Sundays, Wednesdays, Columbus Day (observed), Veterans Day (observed), Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
5. Waterfowl and small game hunters must check out at a check station by 2:00 PM daily.
6. Deer and fall turkey hunting is permitted daily during established deer and fall turkey seasons. Deer and turkey hunters do not need to check in or out, but a reservation is required. Deer and turkey reservations are unlimited in number.
7. All uses other than hunting are prohibited.
