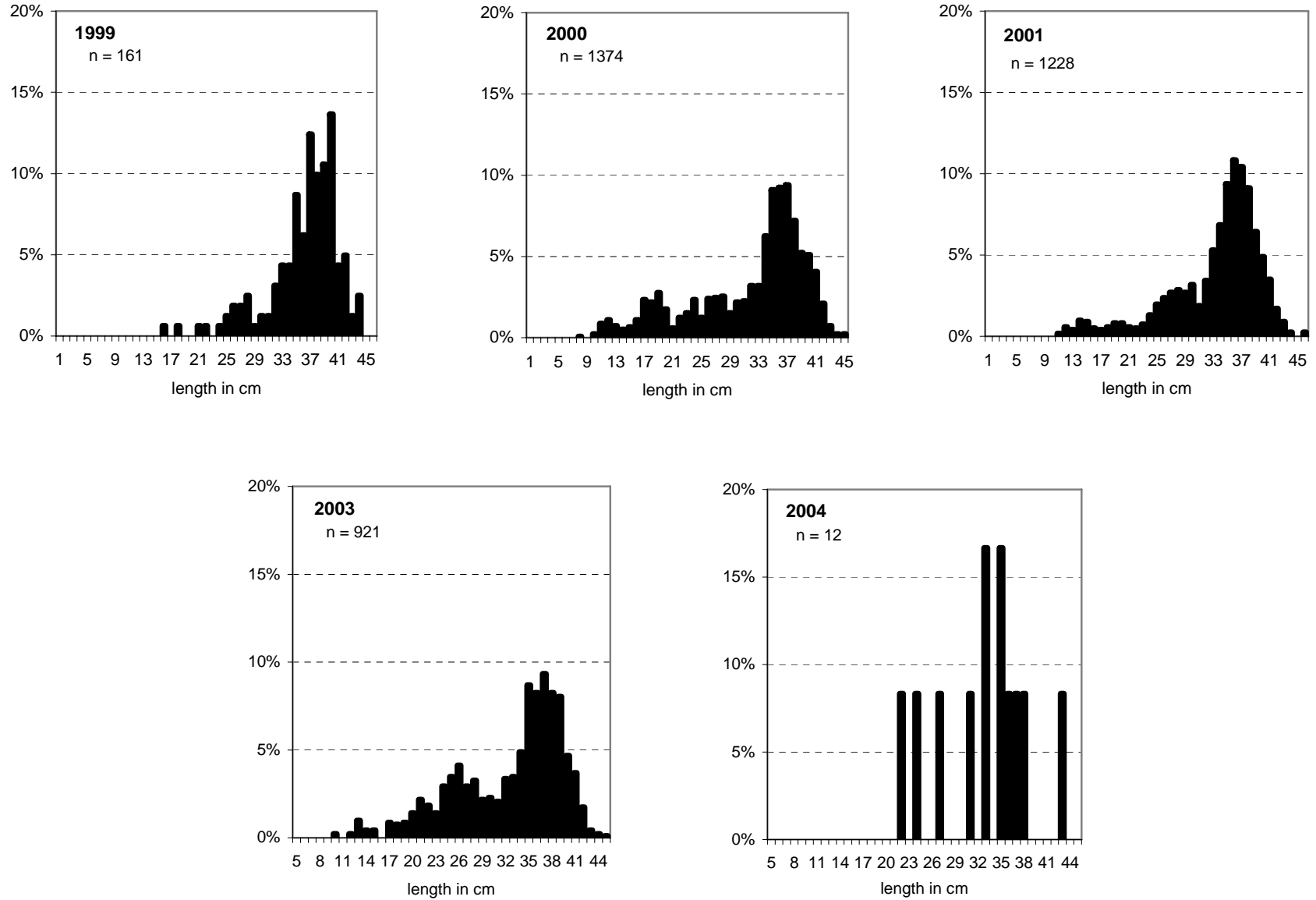


Figure 37. Bluehead sucker, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999*(2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003, and 2004 (backwater surveys).

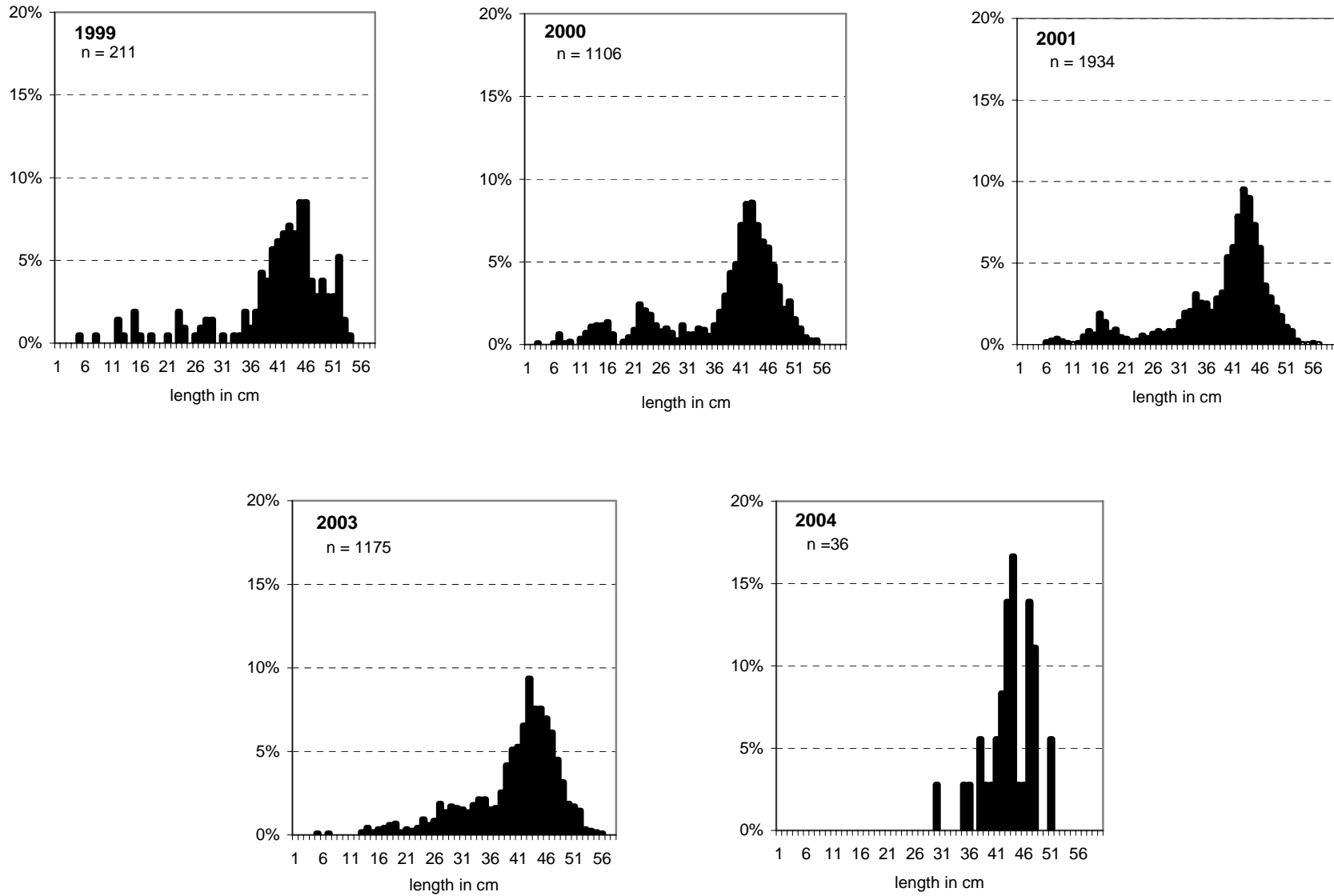


Figure 38. Flannelmouth sucker, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

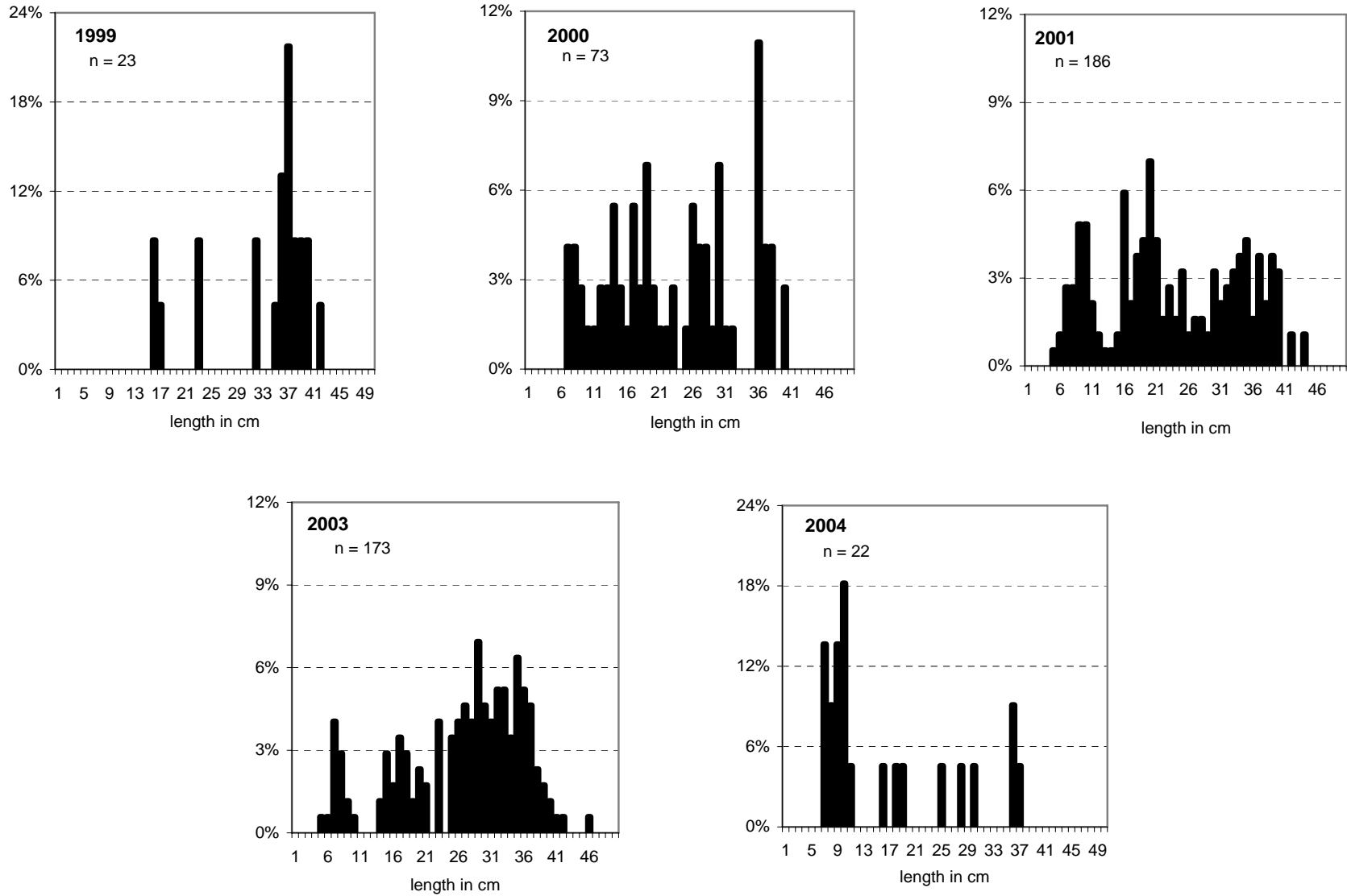


Figure 39. White sucker, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

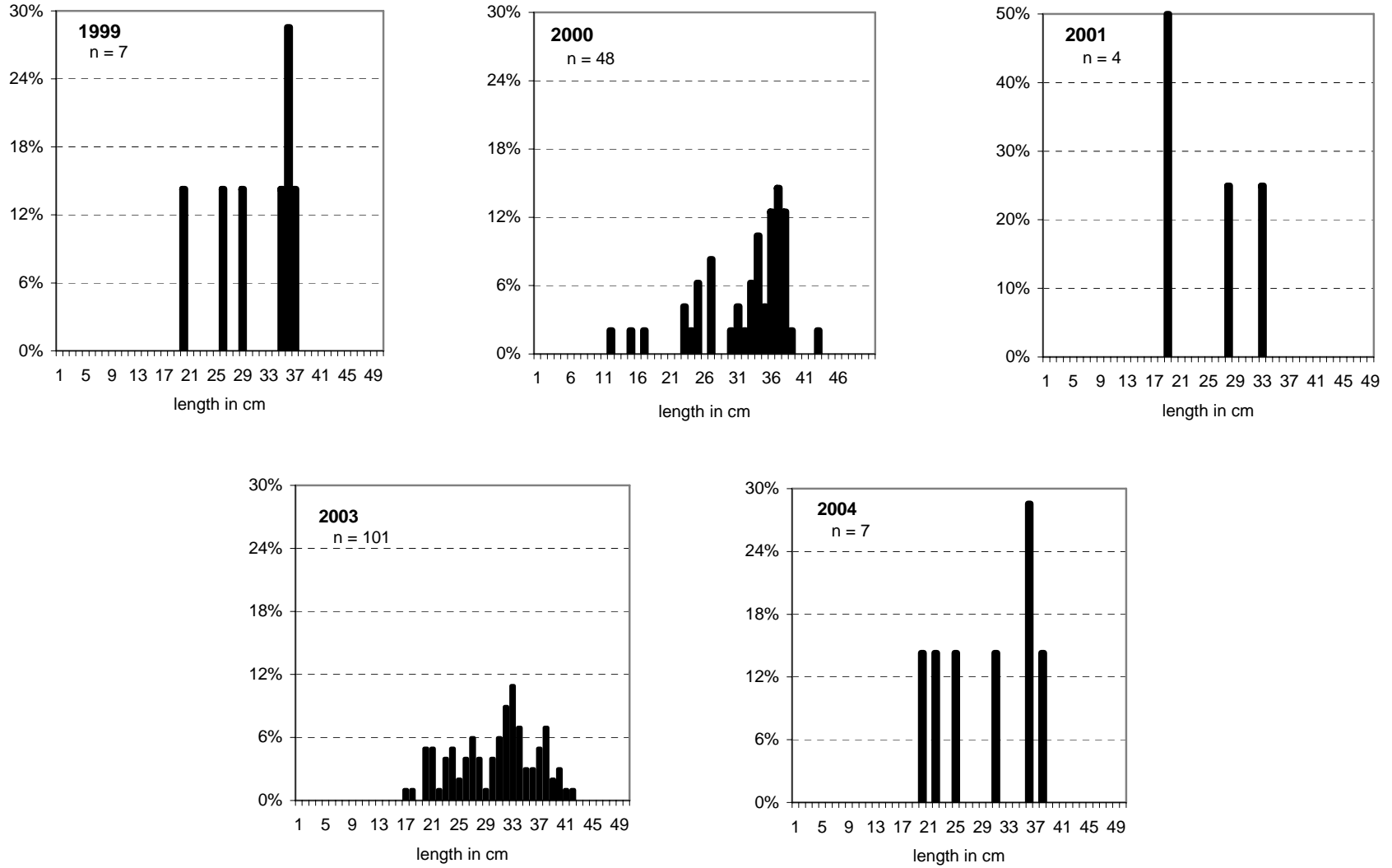


Figure 40. White-bluehead hybrid, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

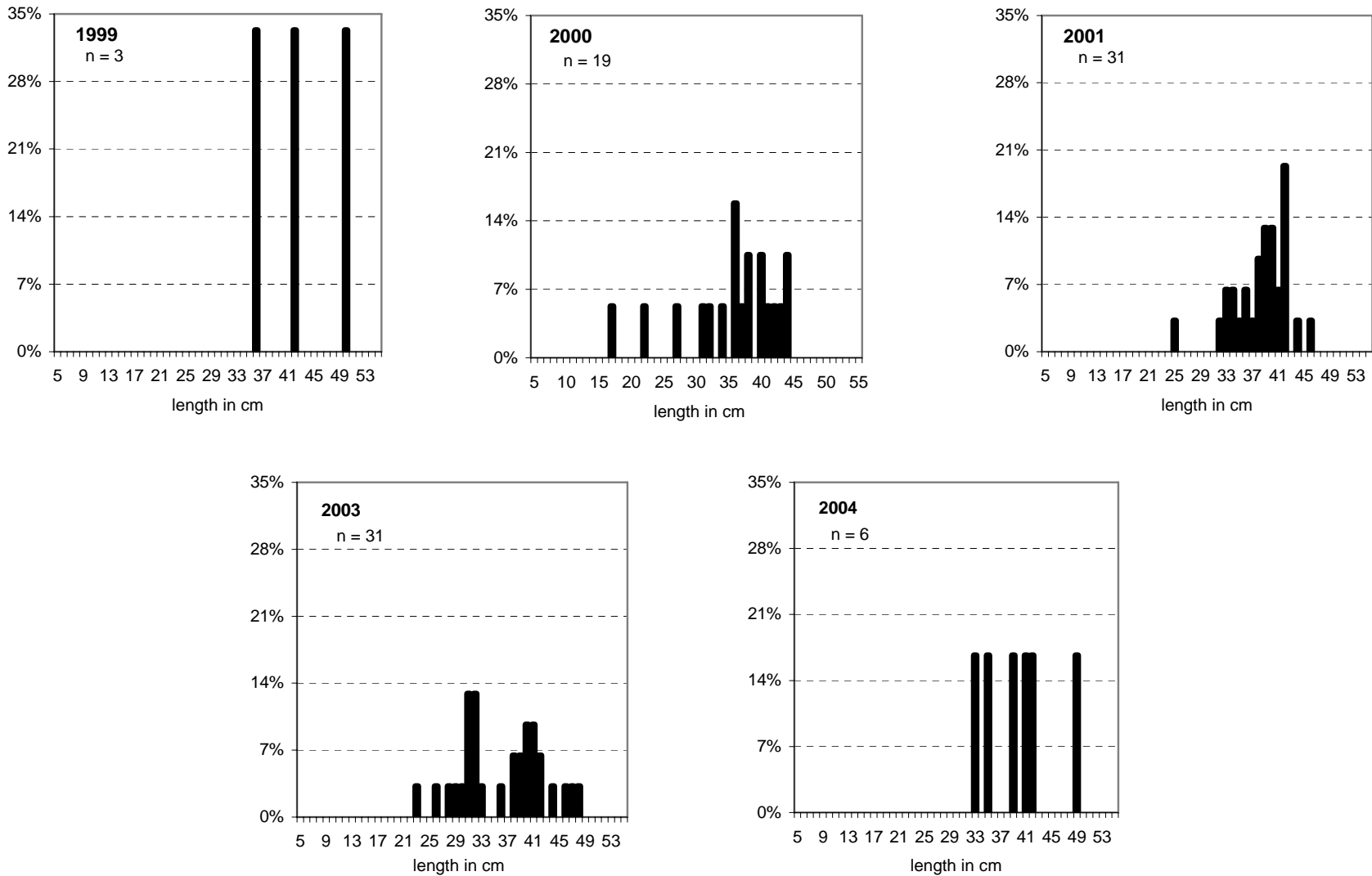


Figure 41. White-flannelmouth hybrid, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003, 2004 (backwater surveys).

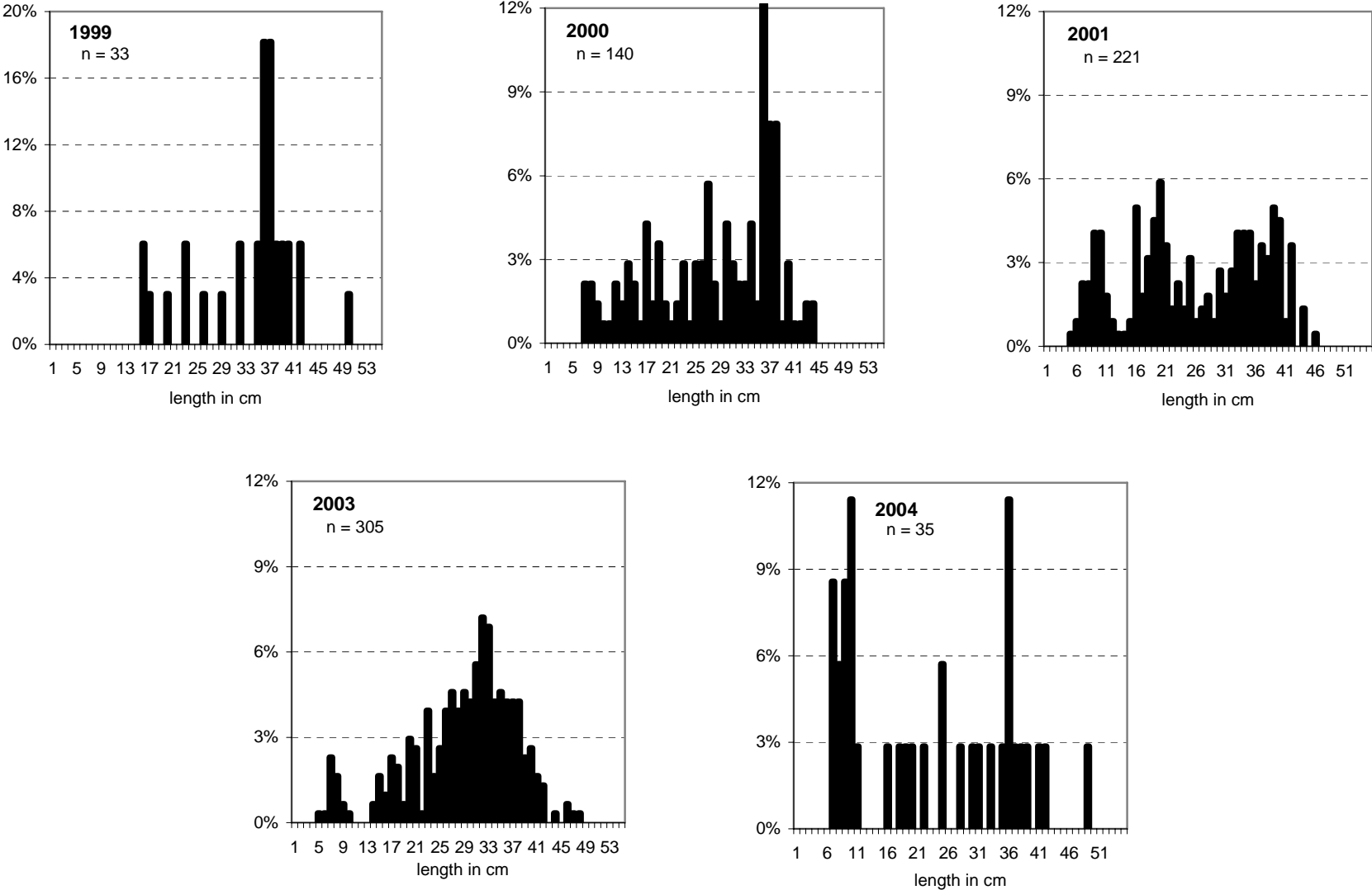


Figure 42. White suckers and hybrids, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

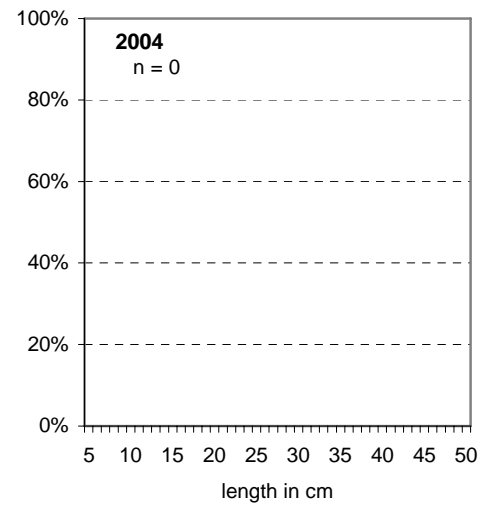
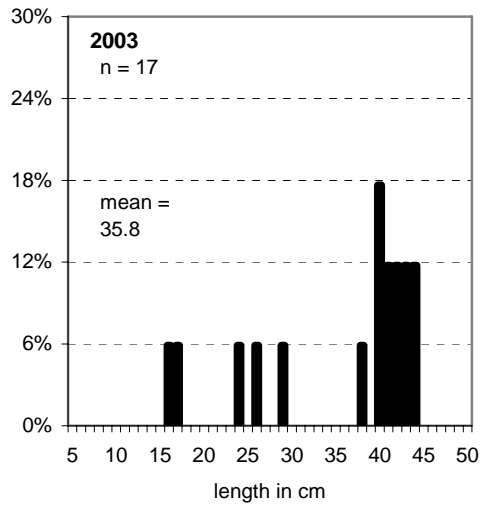
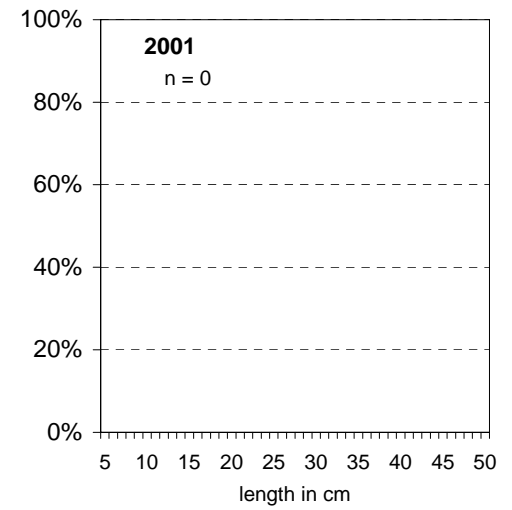
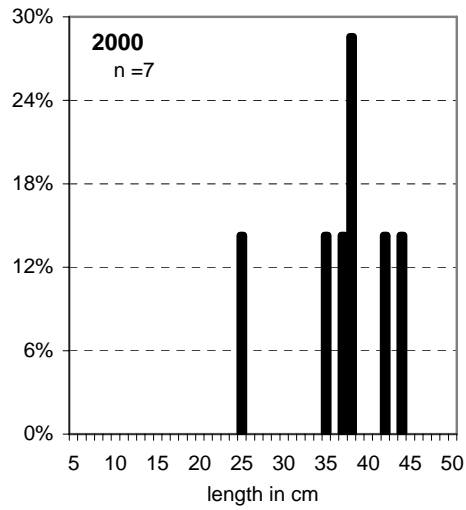
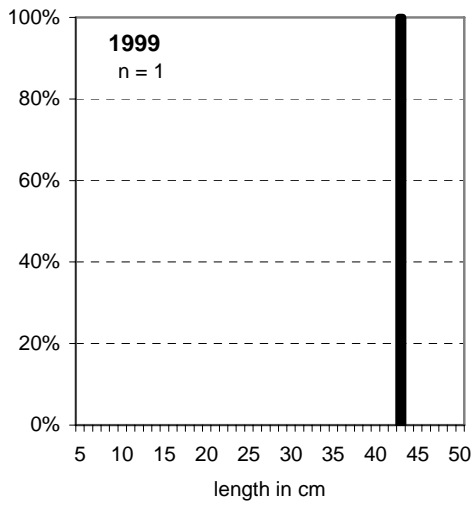


Figure 43. Bluehead-flannelmouth suckers, Clifton, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

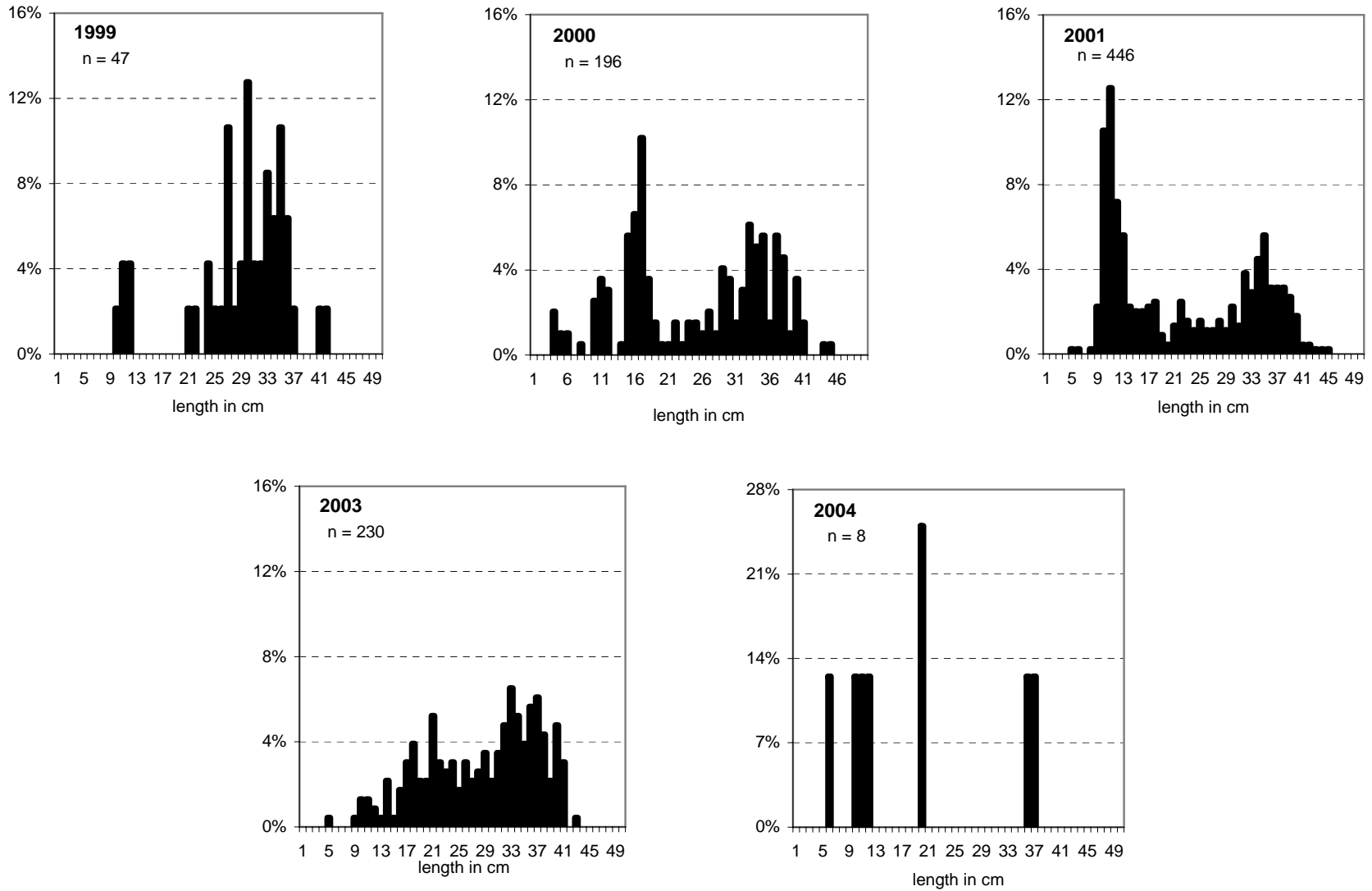


Figure 44. Roundtail chub, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

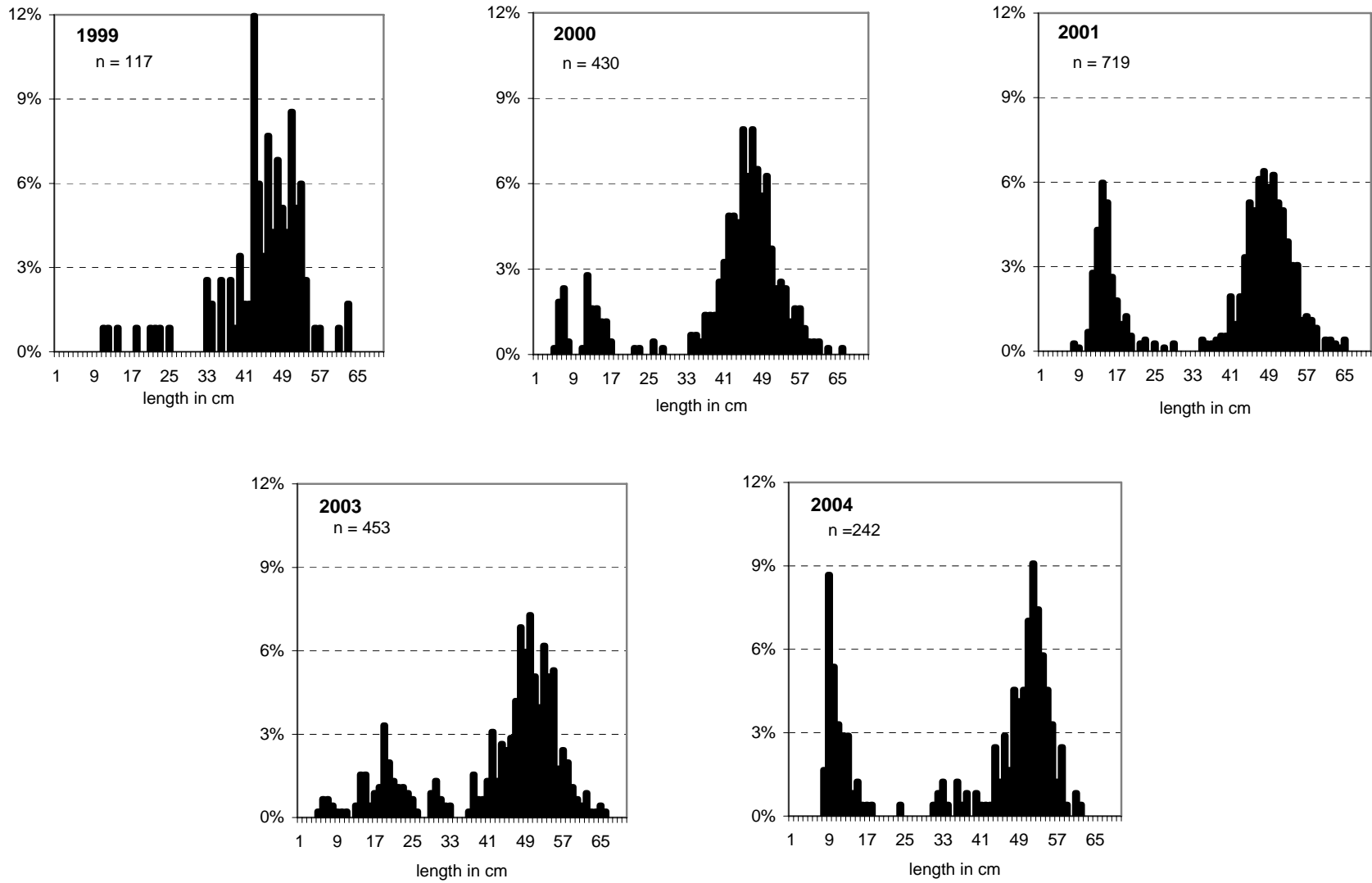


Figure 45. Carp, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

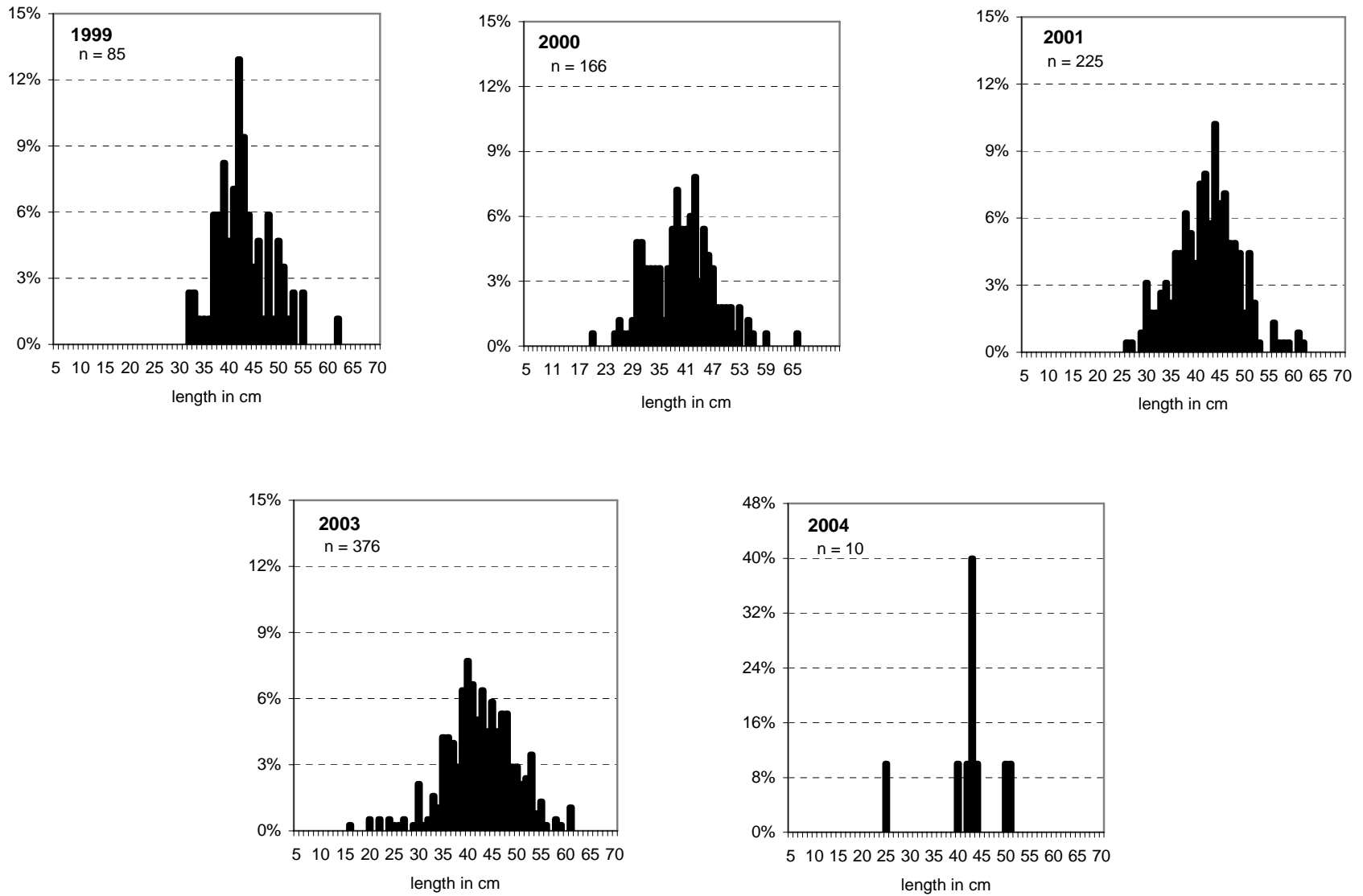


Figure 46. Channel catfish, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

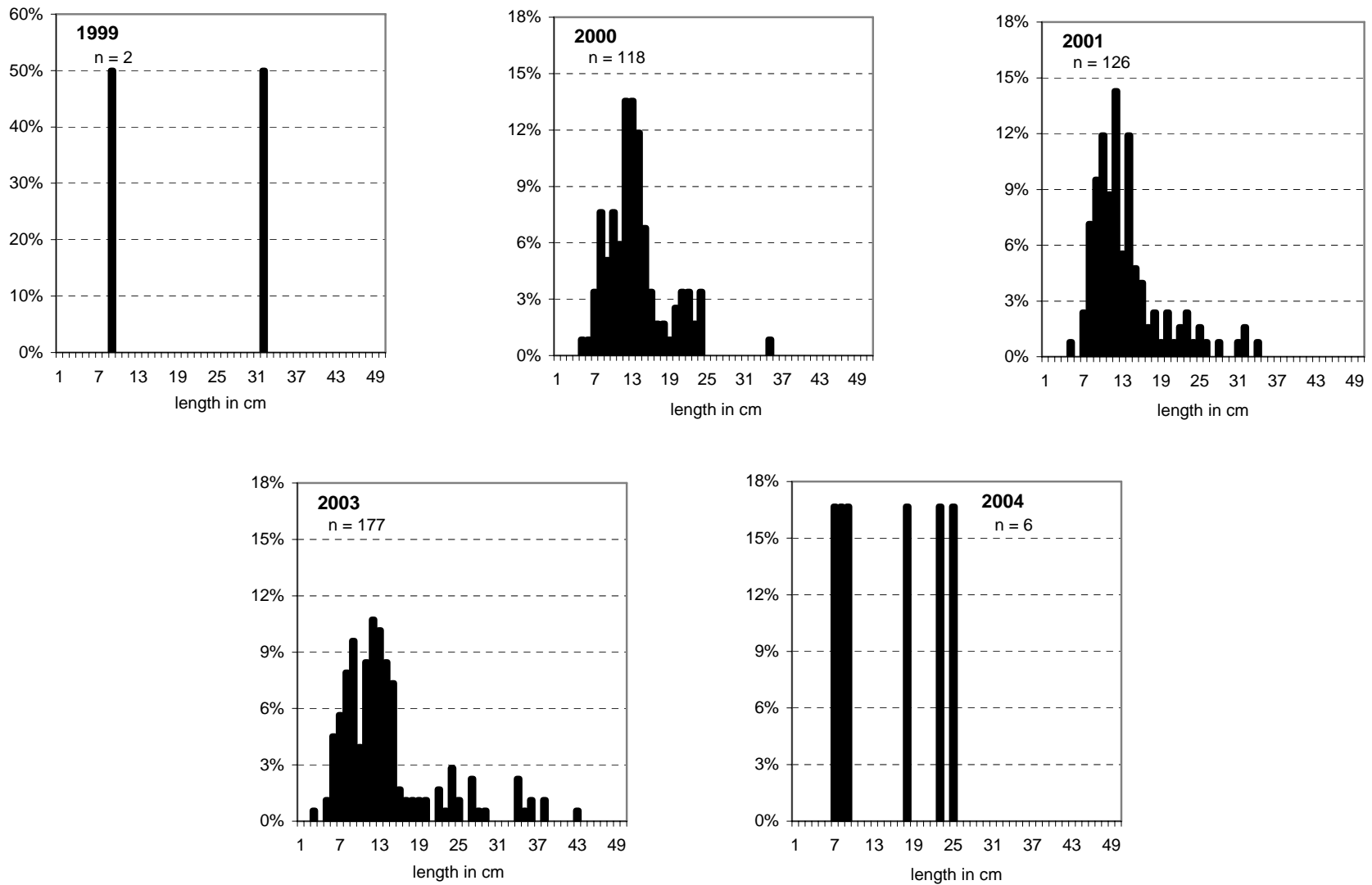


Figure 47. Largemouth bass, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

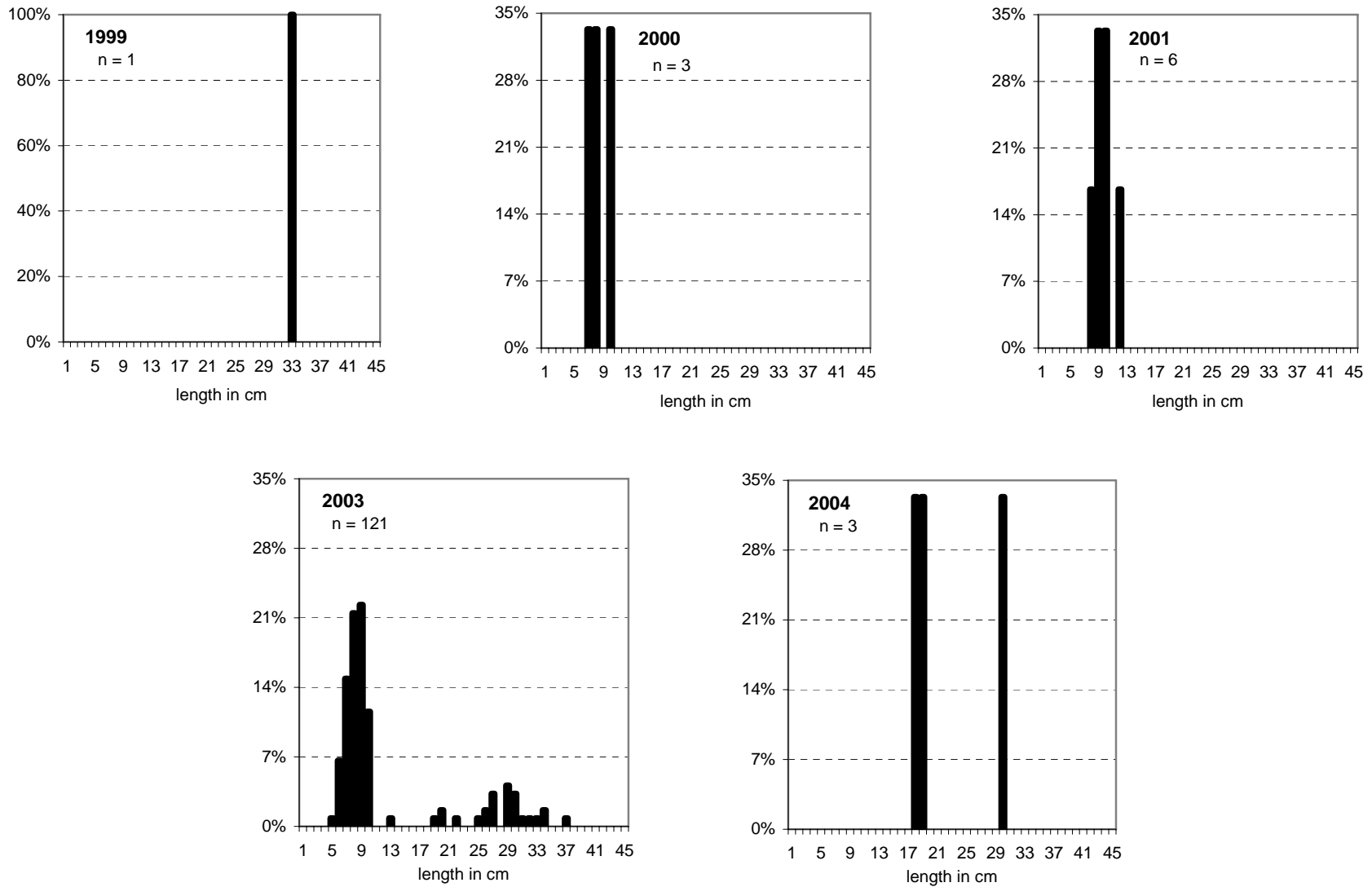


Figure 48. Smallmouth bass, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

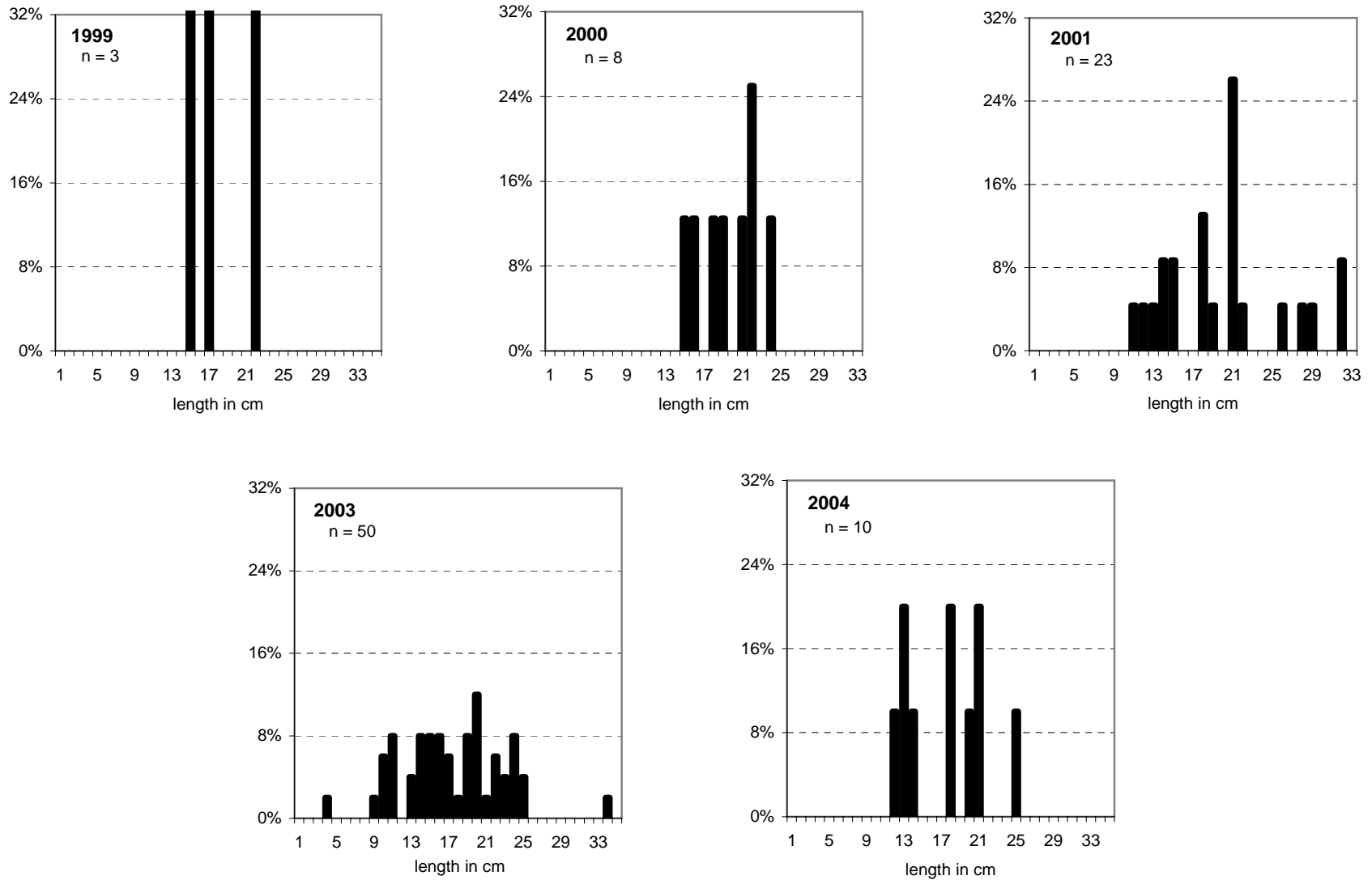


Figure 49. Black bullhead, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

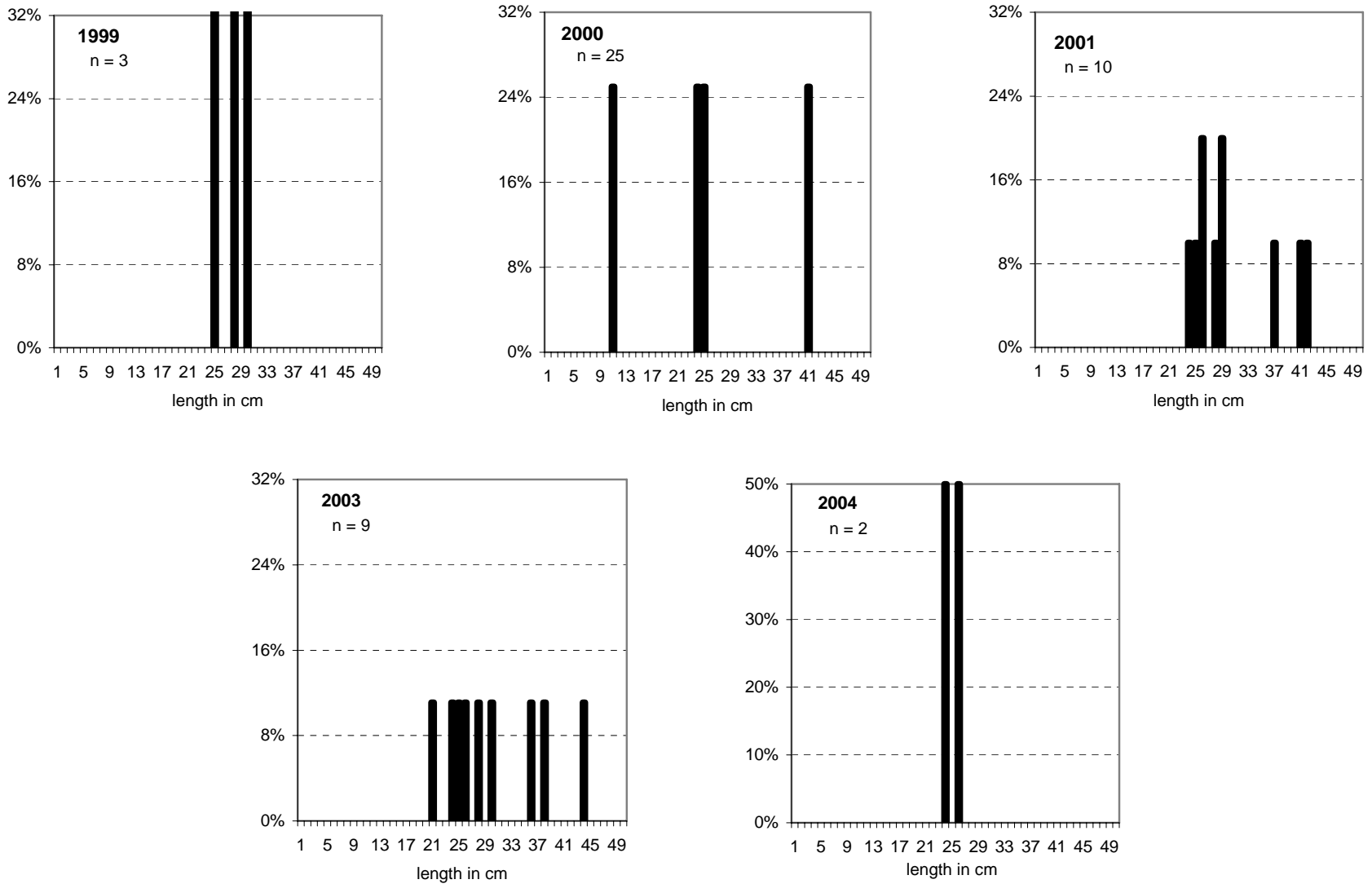


Figure 50. Brown trout, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

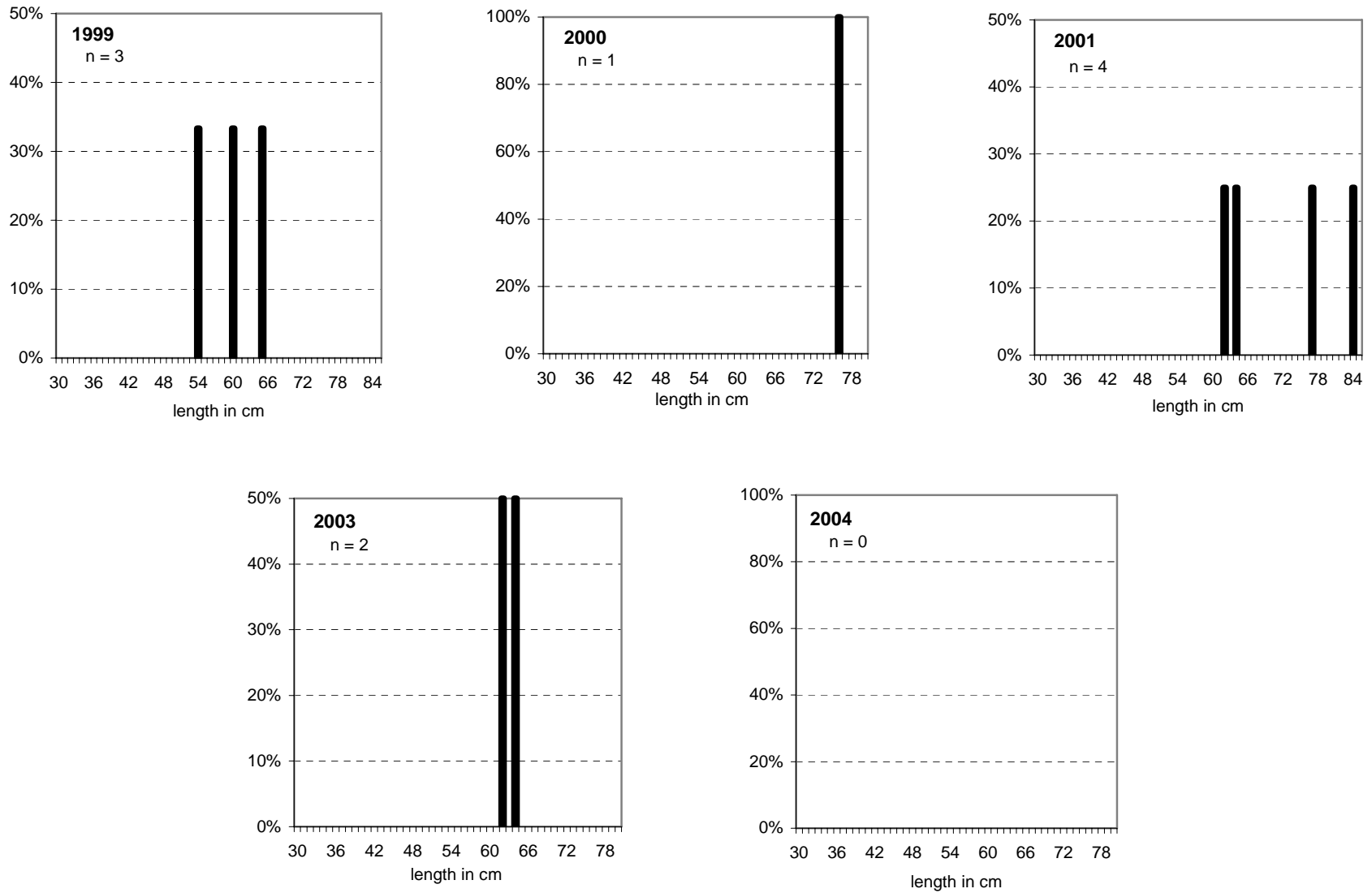


Figure 51. Colorado pikeminnow, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

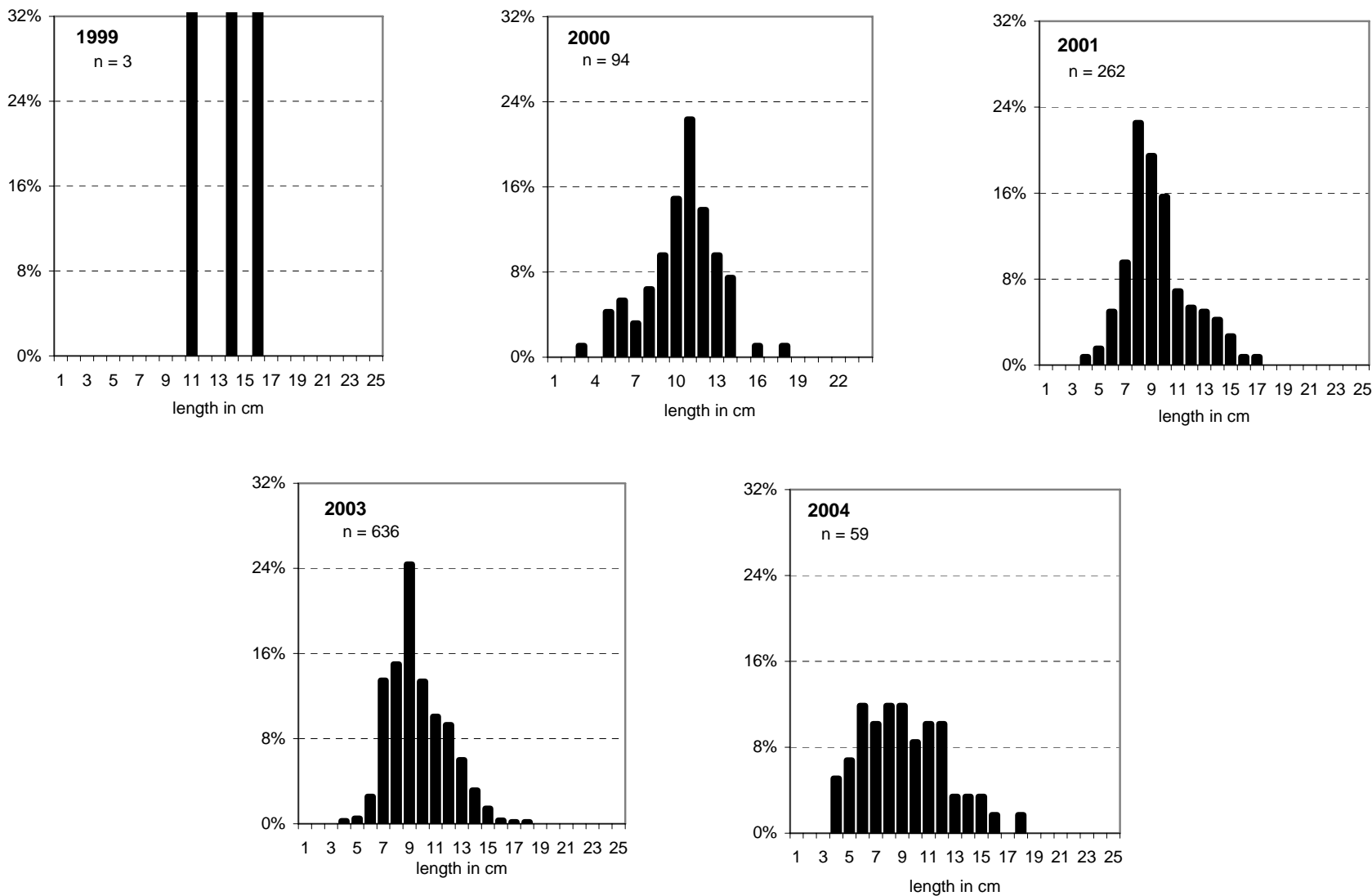


Figure 52. Green sunfish, Clifton, Colorado River, 1999 (2 passes), 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004 (backwater surveys).

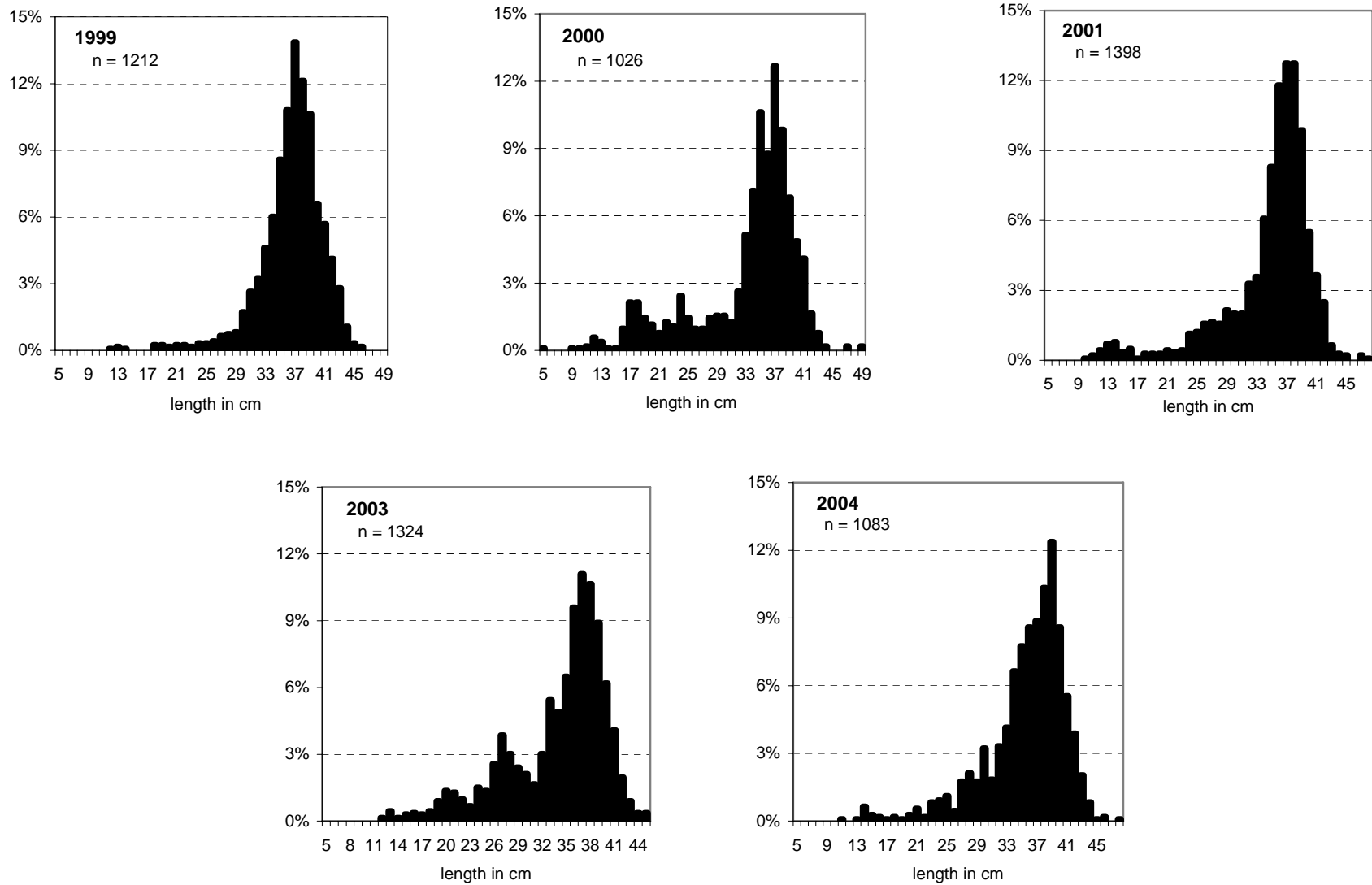


Figure 53. Bluehead sucker, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

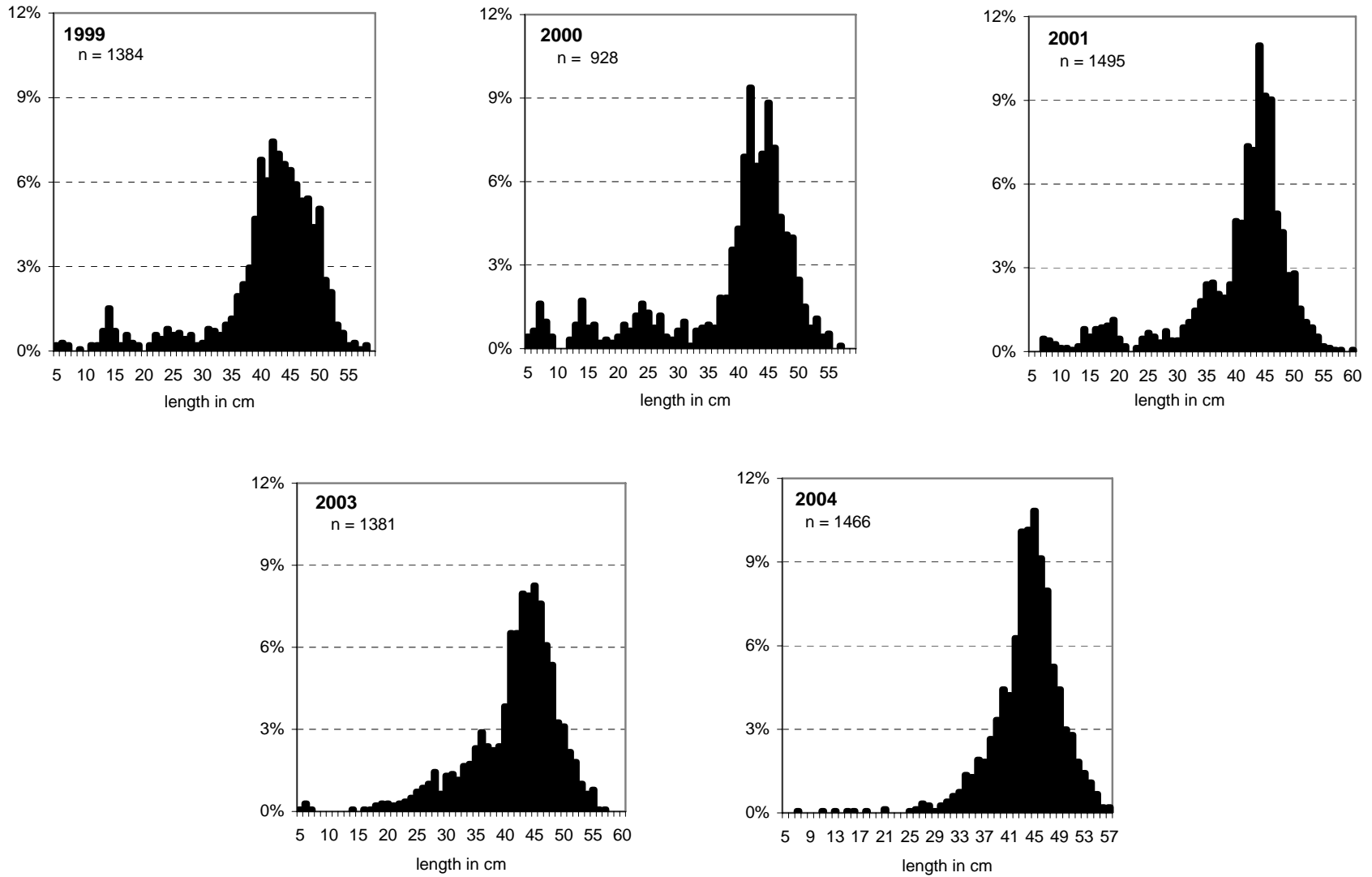


Figure 54. Flannelmouth sucker, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

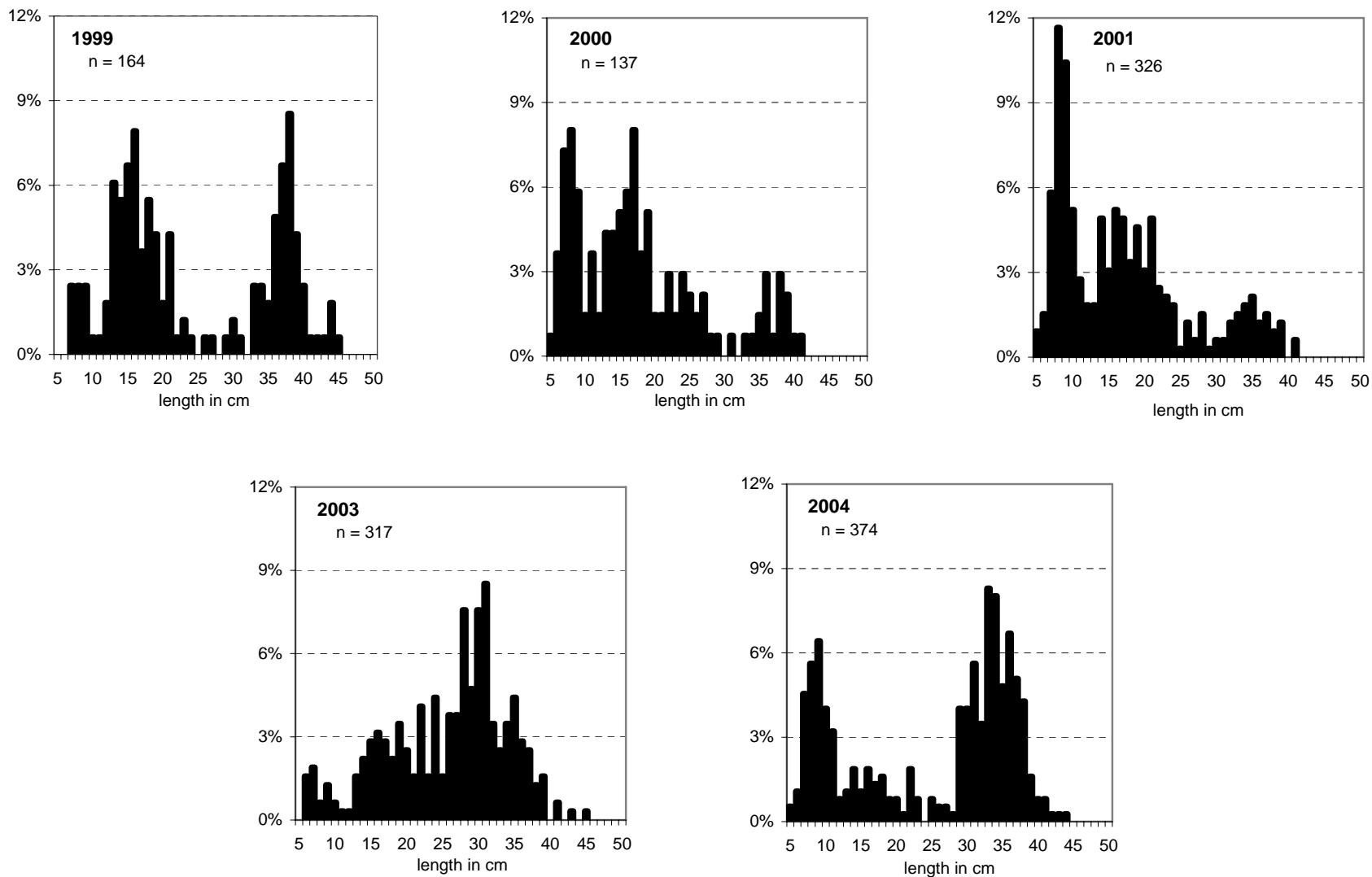


Figure 55. White sucker, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

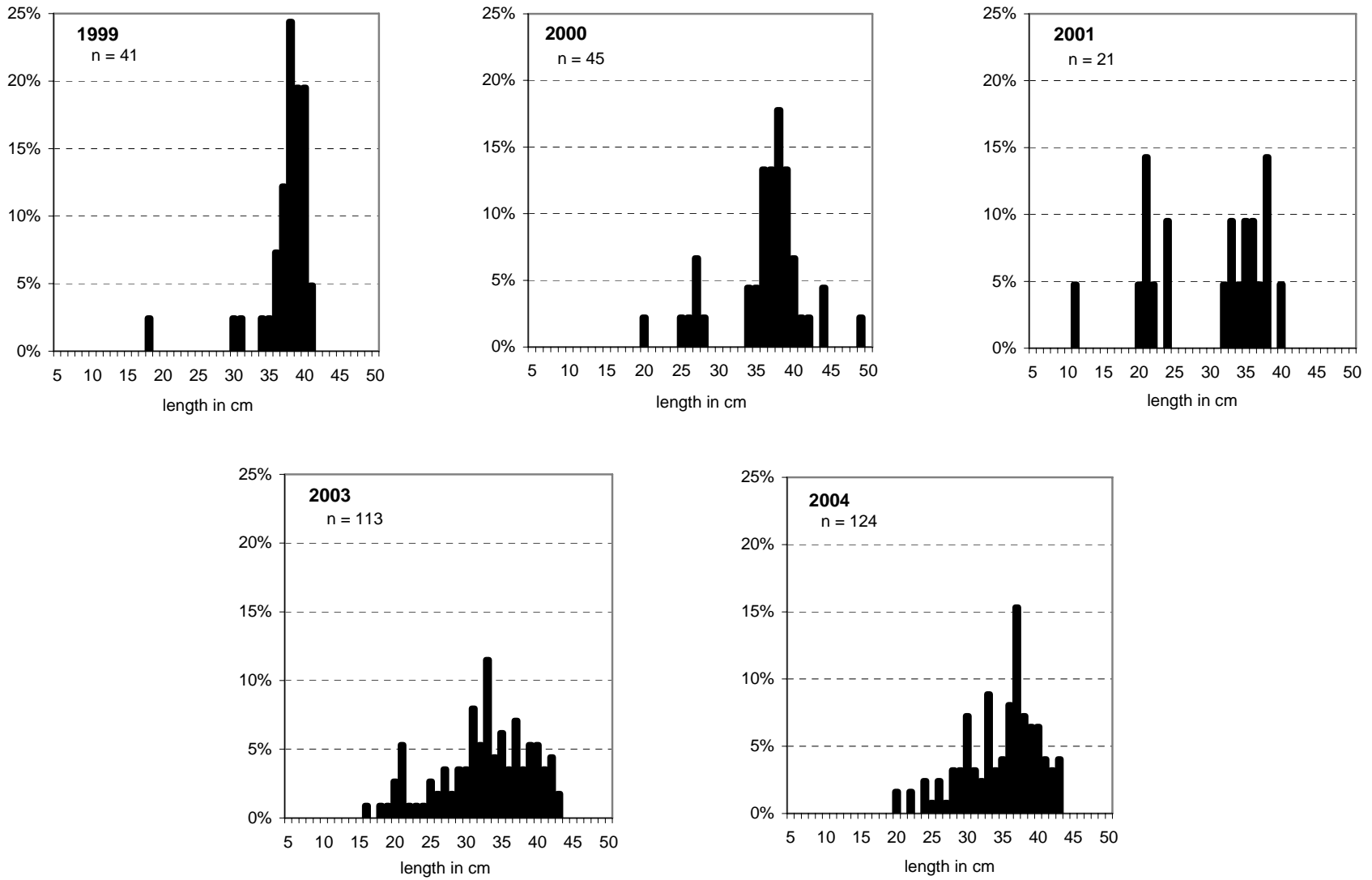


Figure 56. White-bluehead hybrid, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

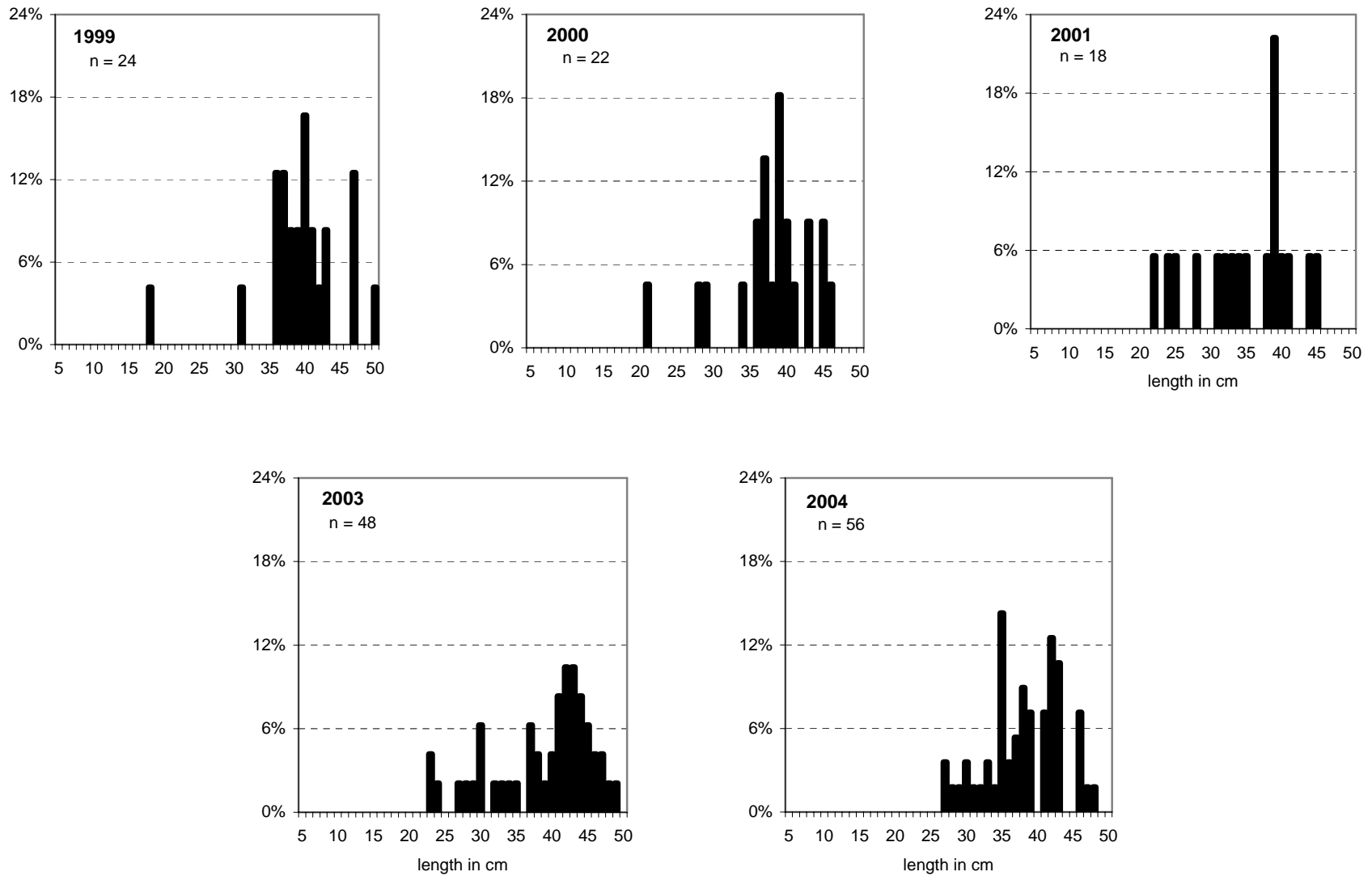


Figure 57. White-flannelmouth hybrid, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

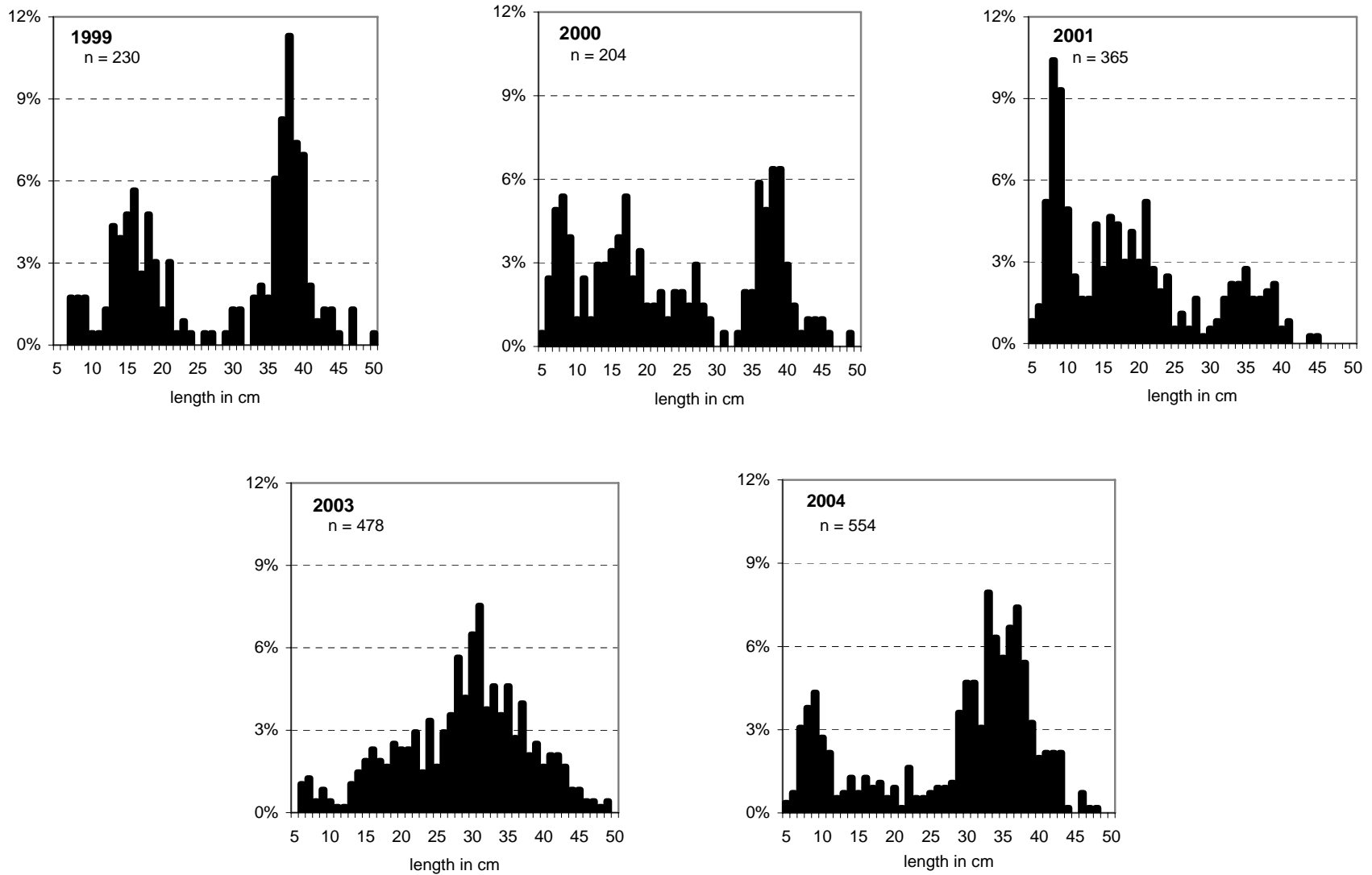


Figure 58. White sucker and hybrids, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

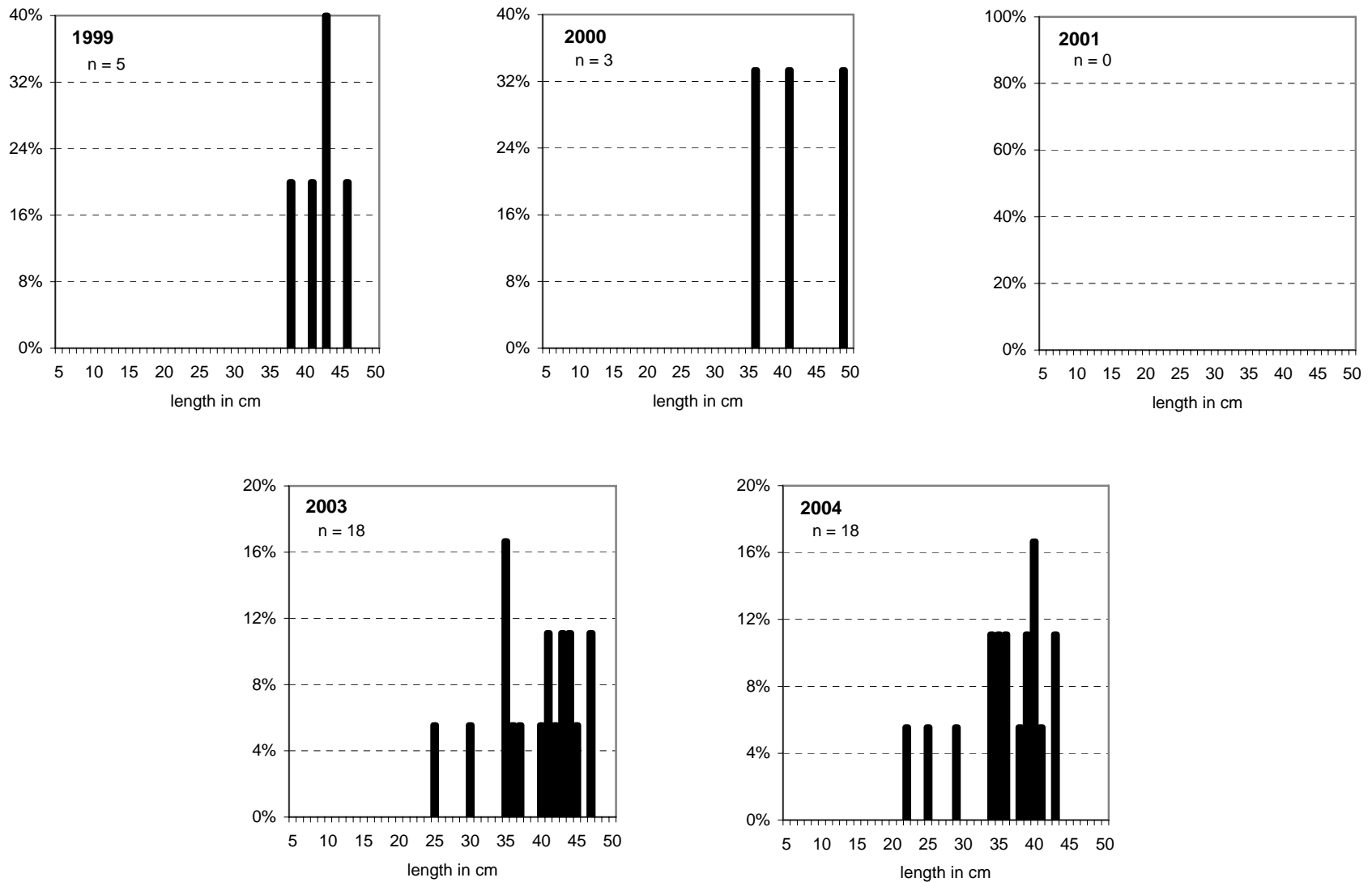


Figure 59. Bluehead-flannelmouth sucker, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

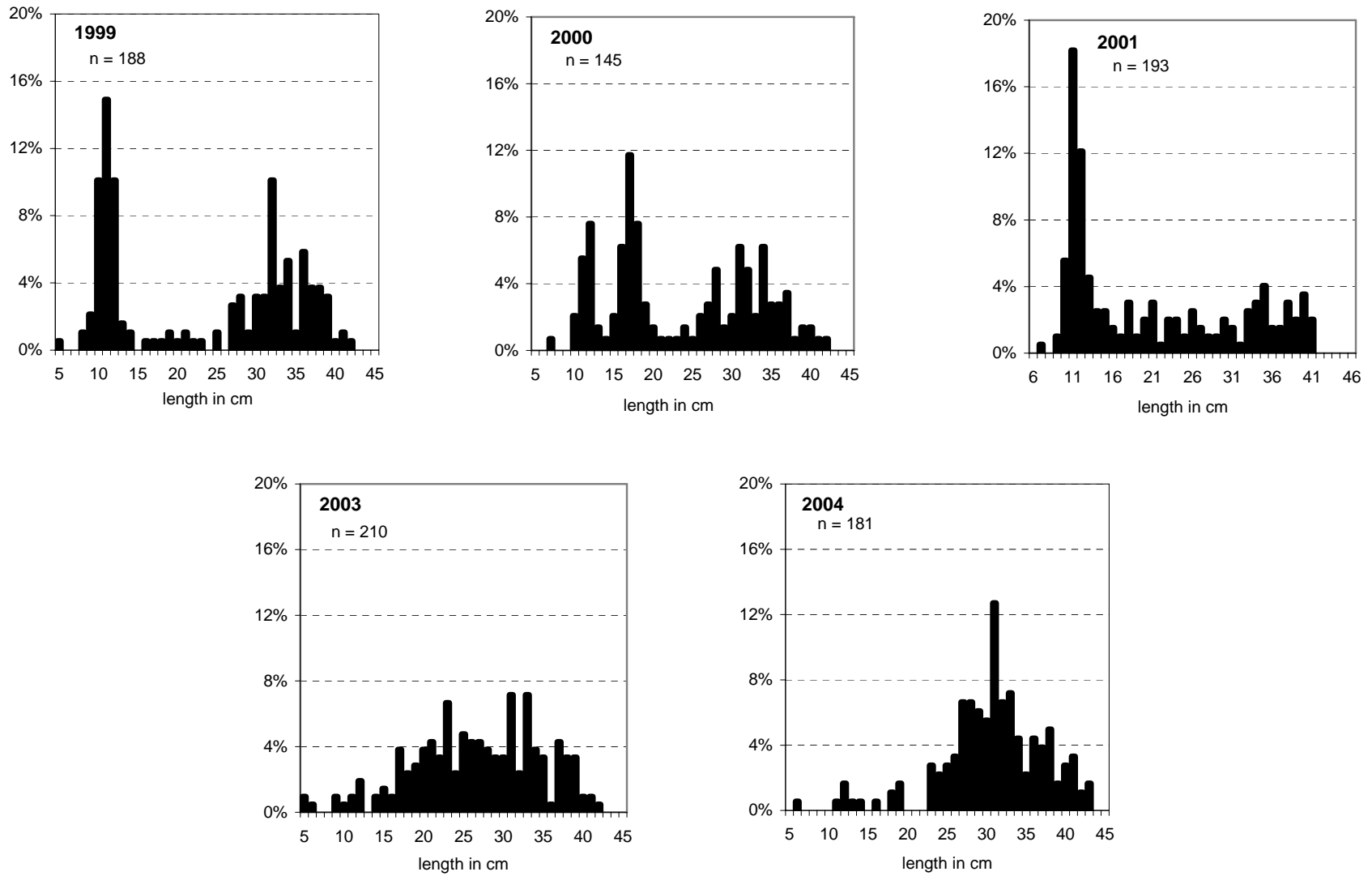


Figure 60. Roundtail chub, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

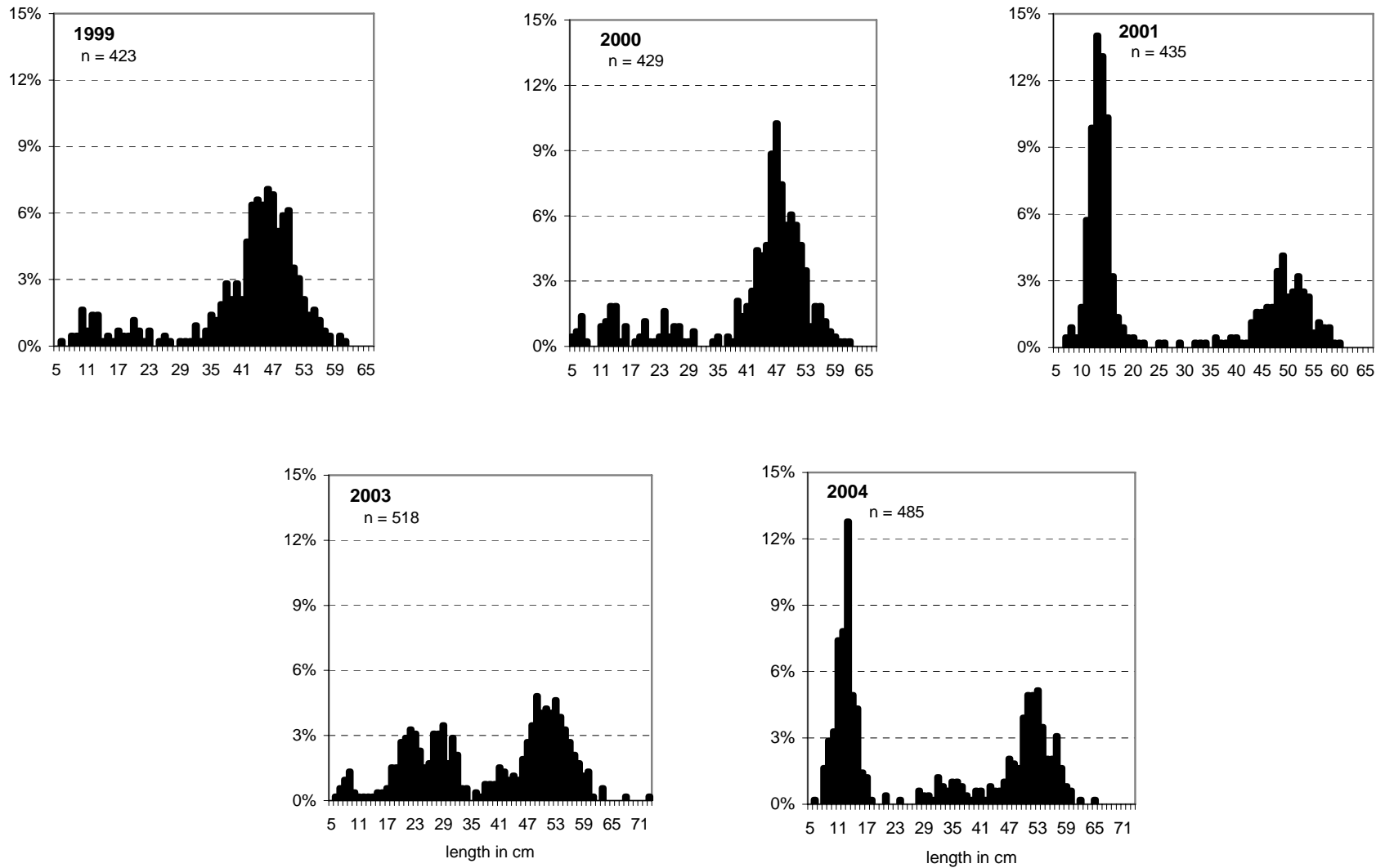


Figure 61. Carp, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

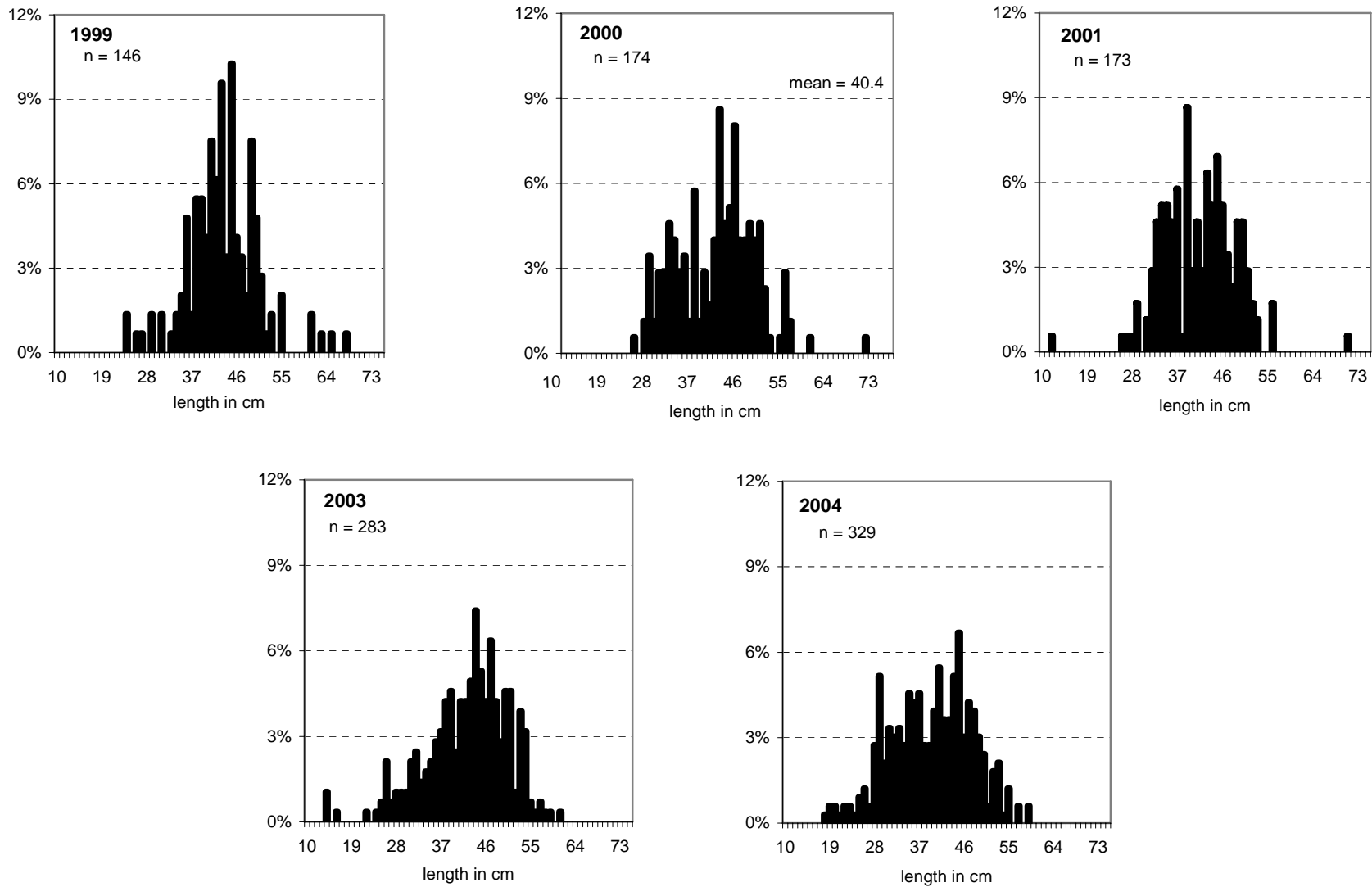


Figure 62. Channel catfish, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

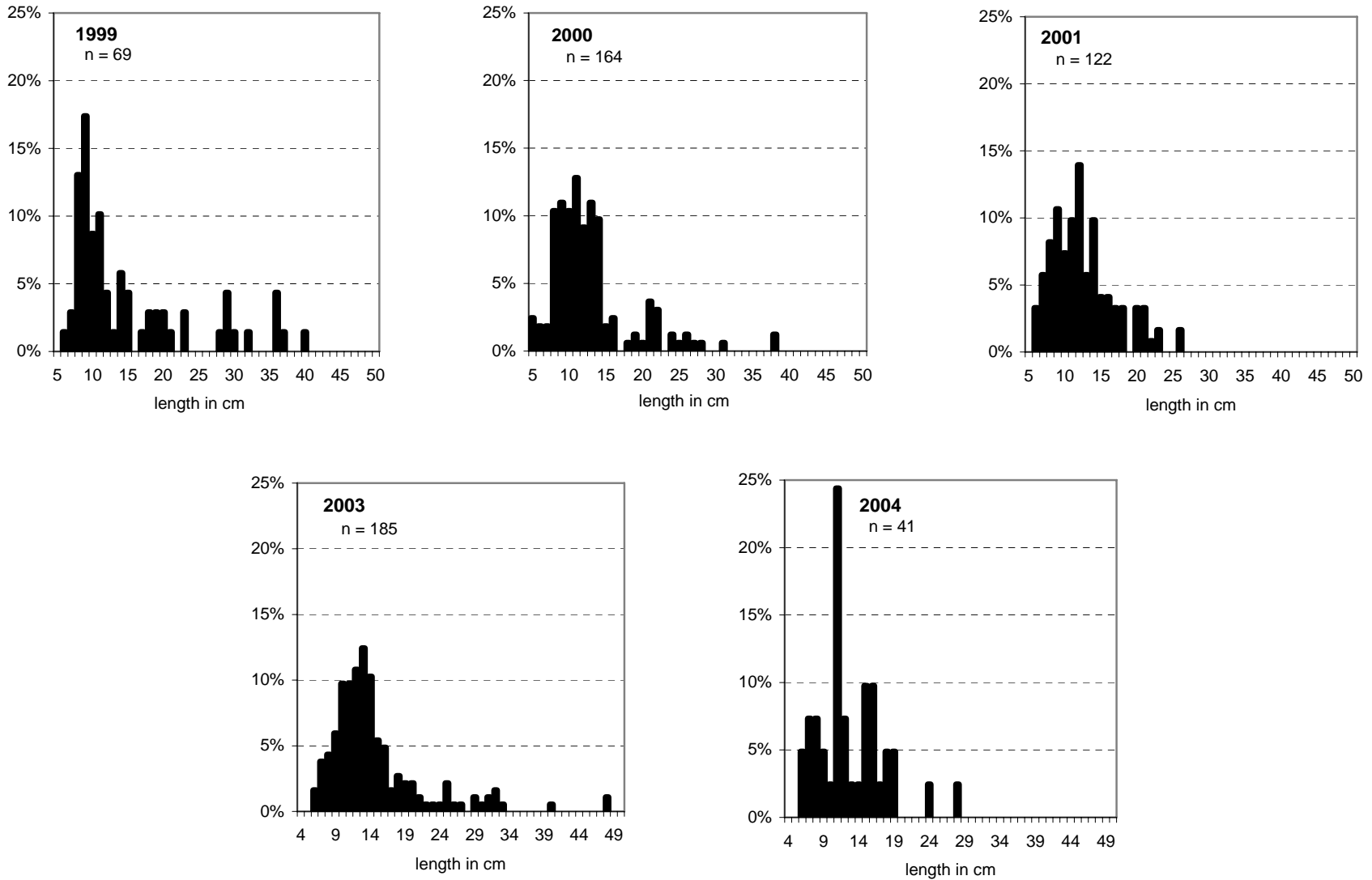


Figure 63. Largemouth bass, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

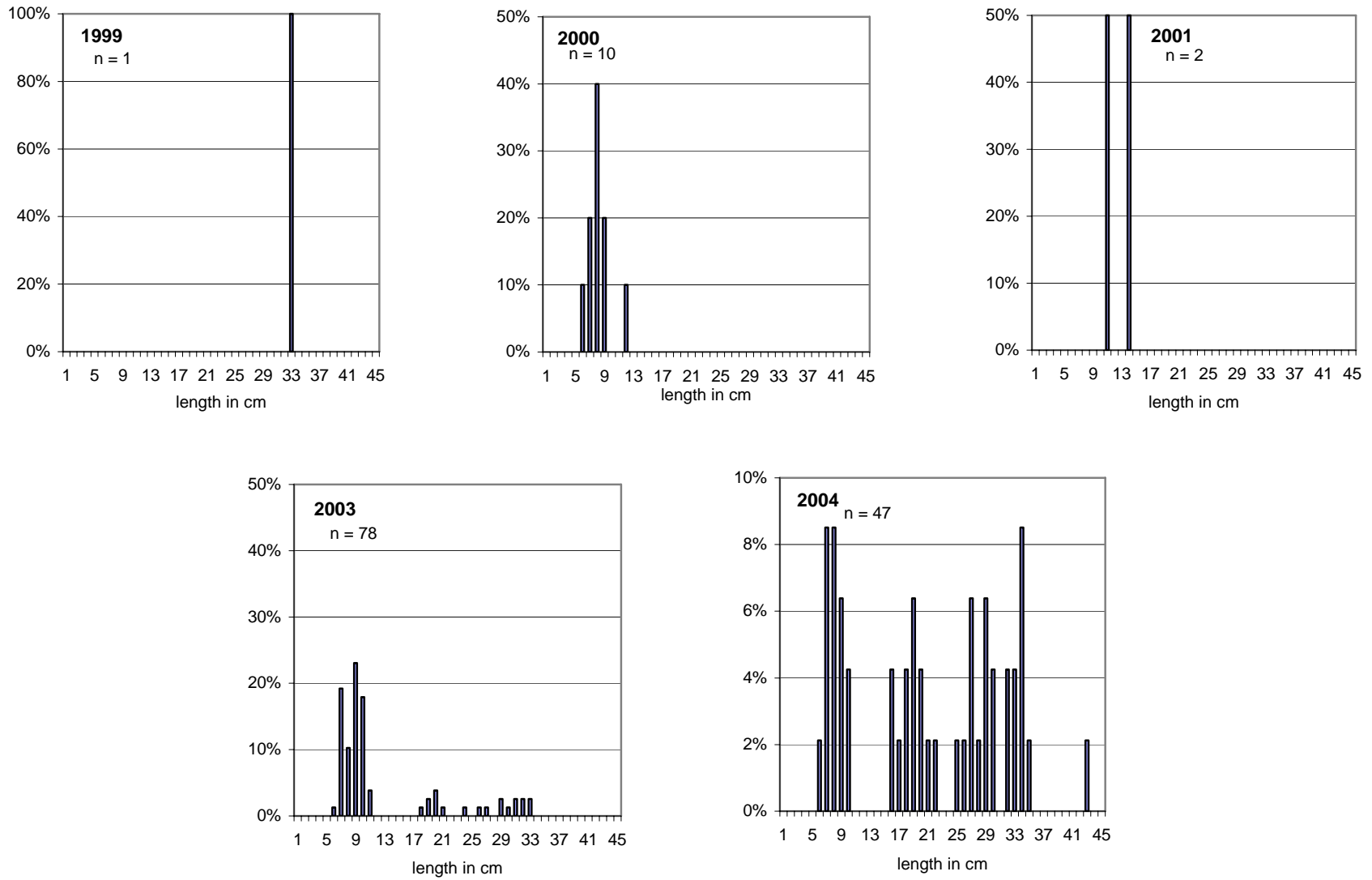


Figure 64. Smallmouth bass, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

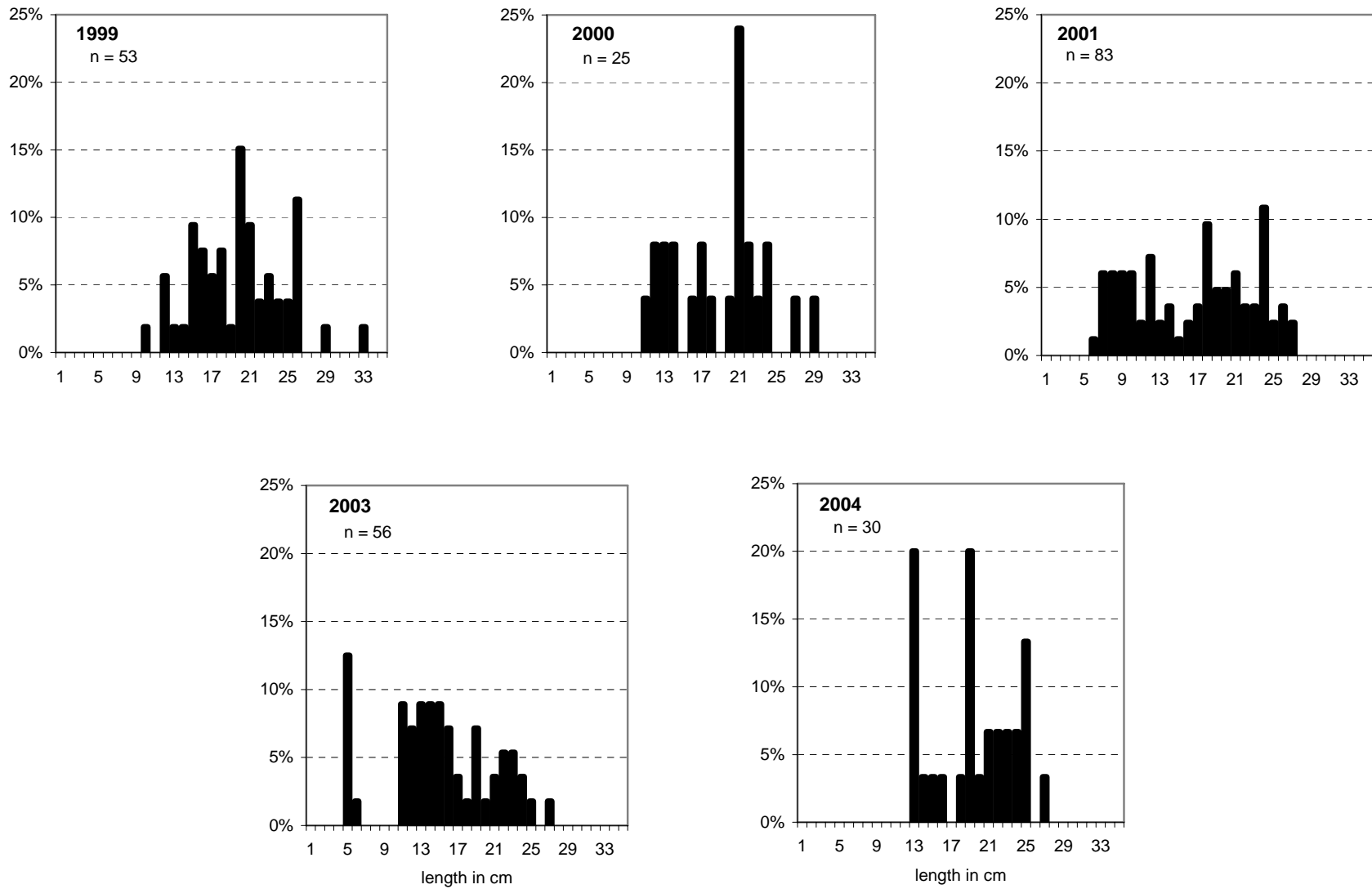


Figure 65. Black bullhead, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

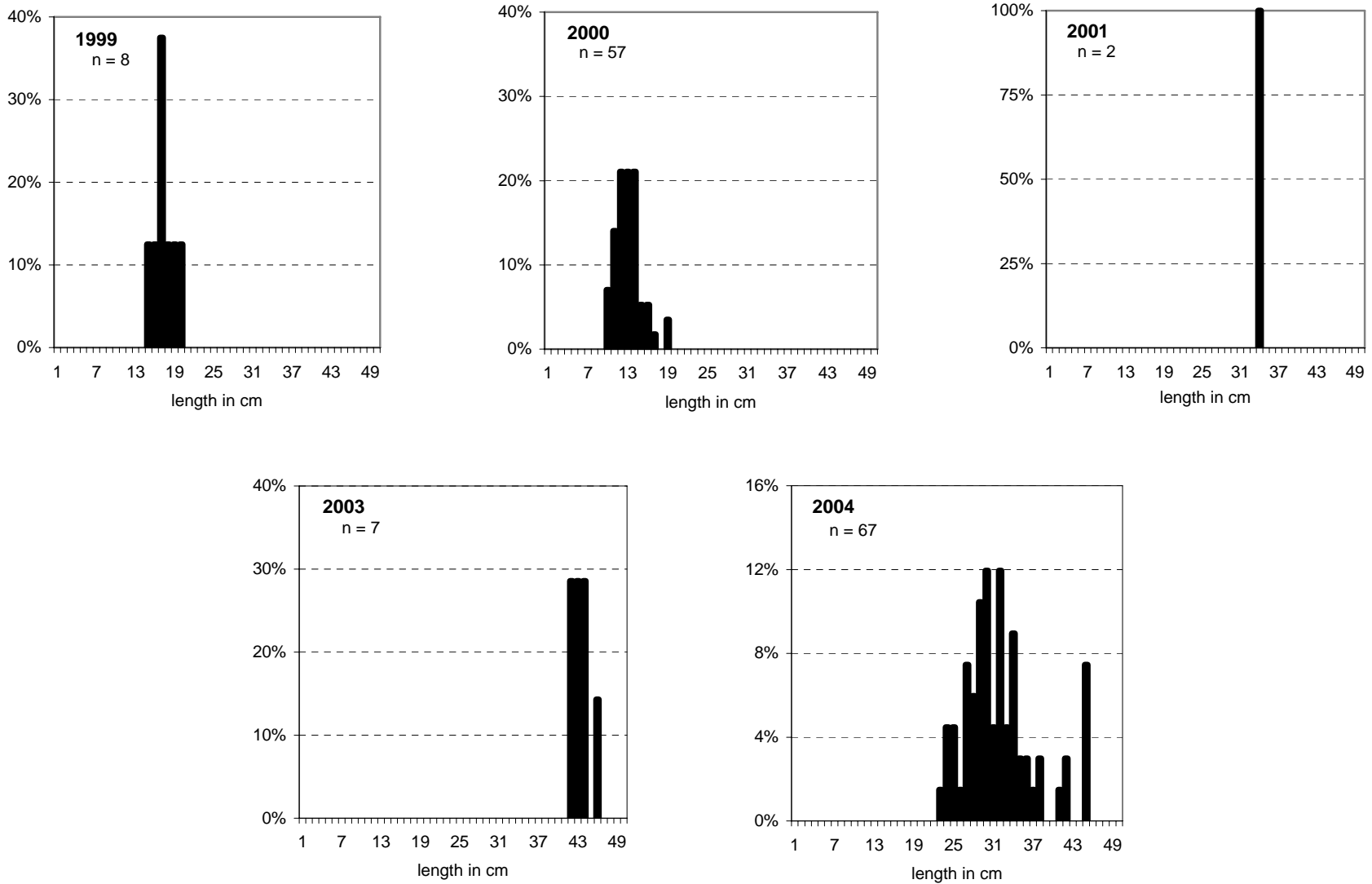


Figure 66. Razorback sucker, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

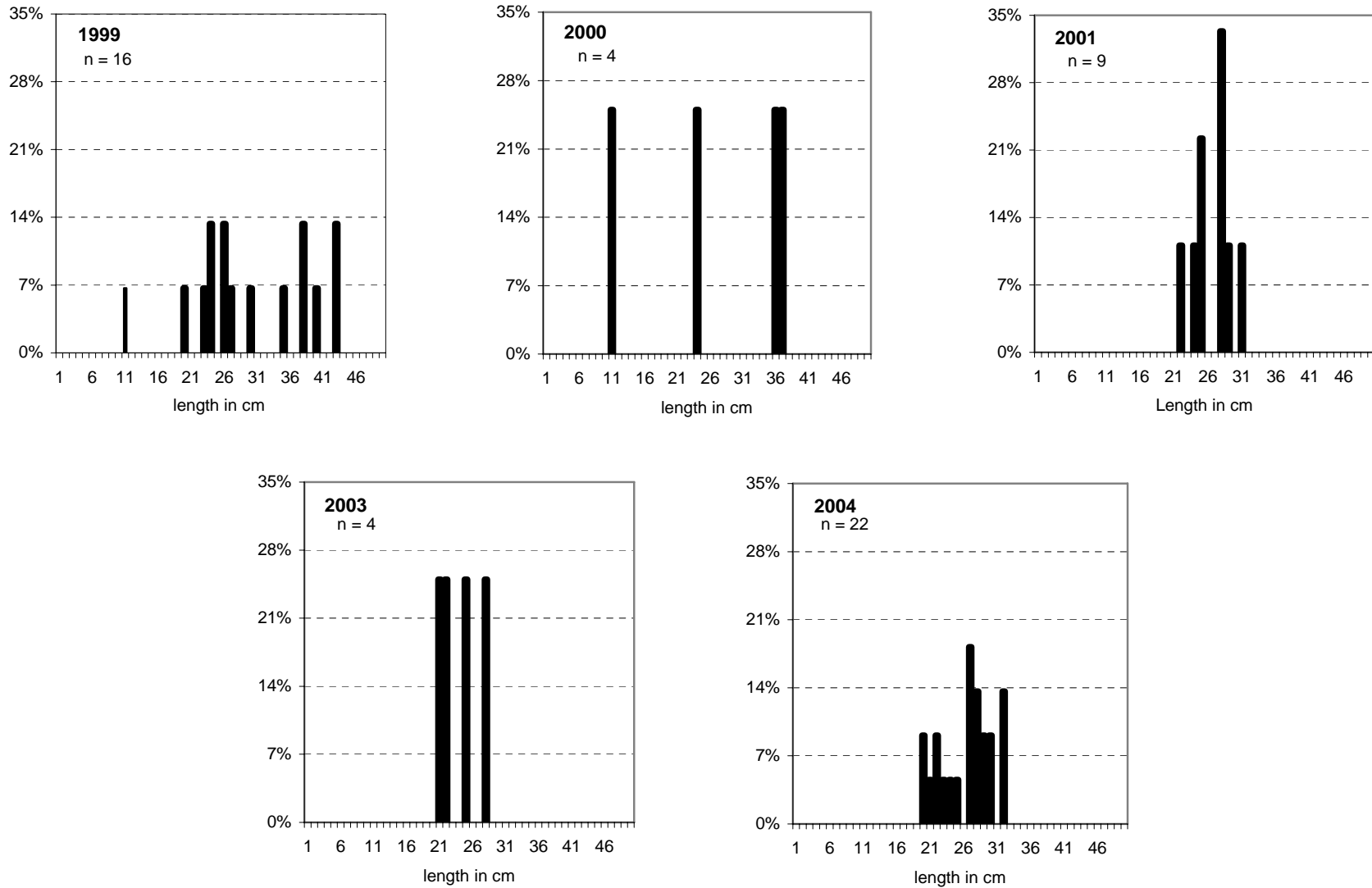


Figure 67. Brown trout, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

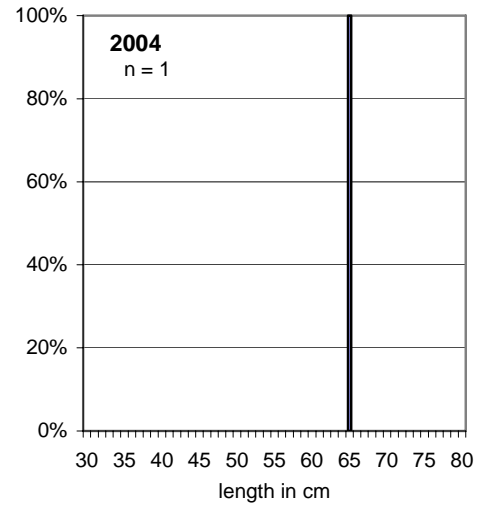
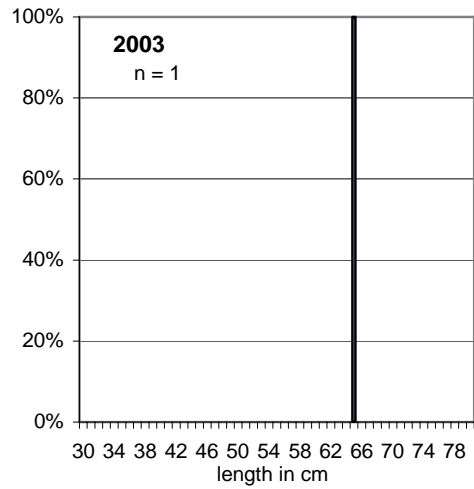
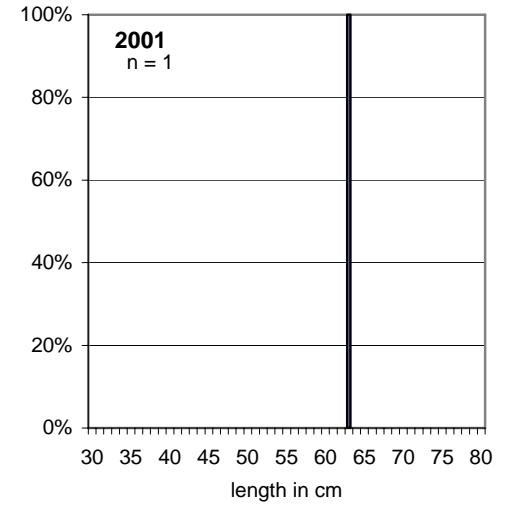
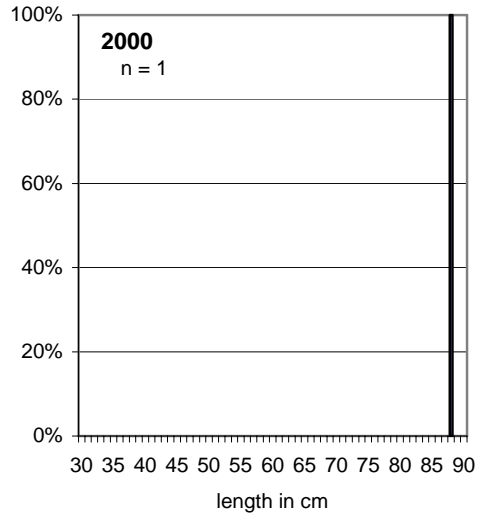
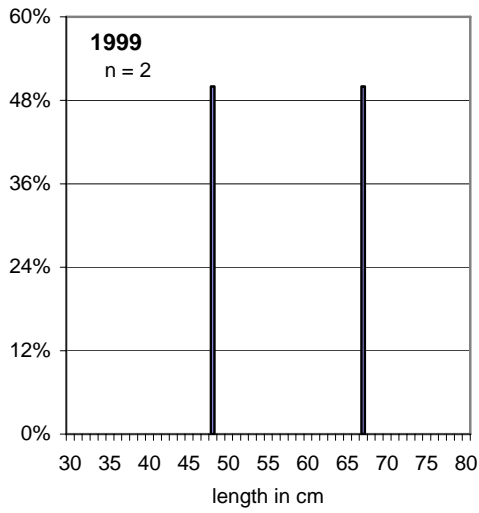


Figure 68. Colorado pikeminnow, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.

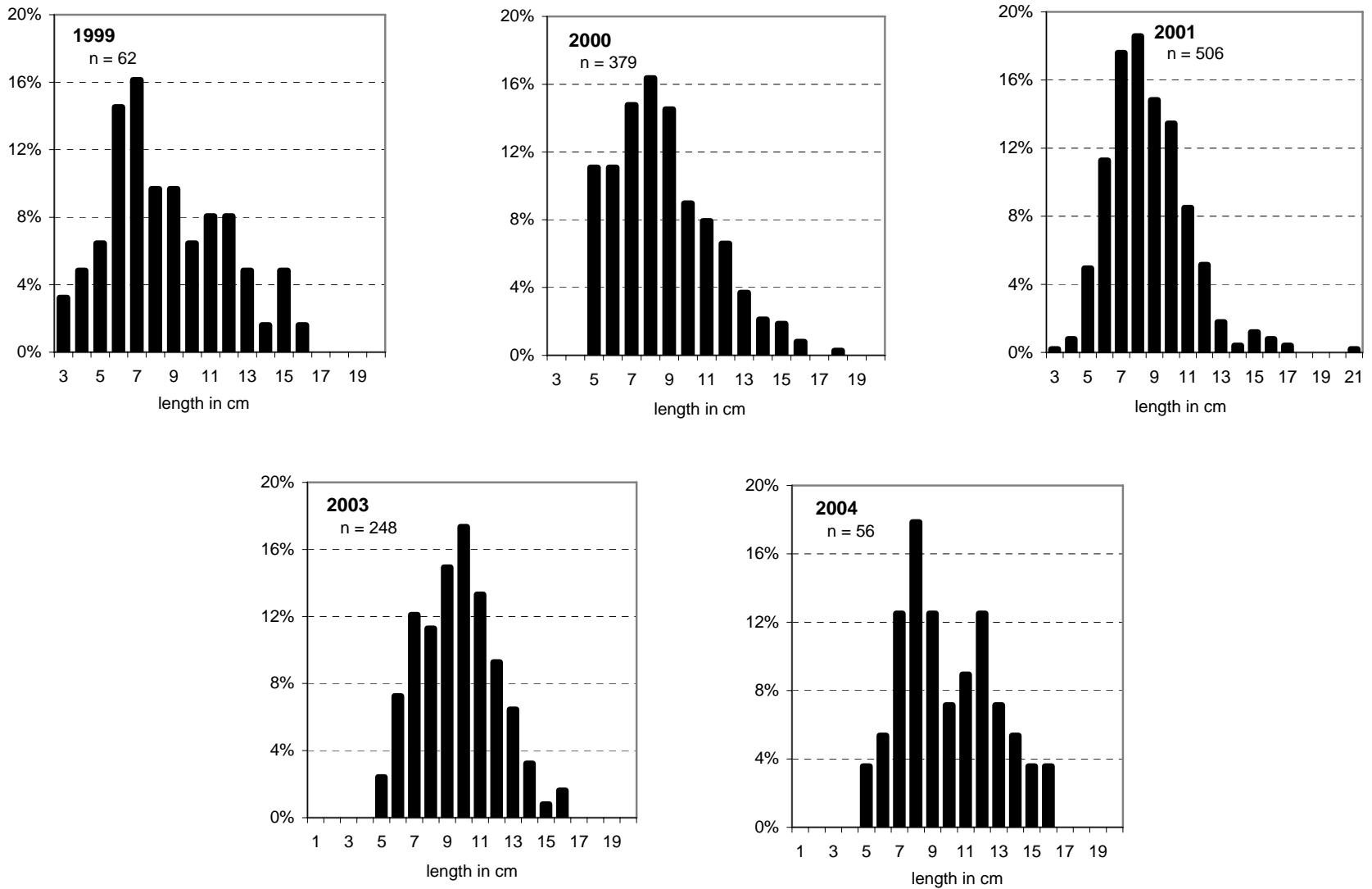


Figure 69. Green sunfish, Corn Lake, Colorado River, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004.
