SMALL GAME V.S. SMALL GAME WALK-IN ACCESS

Small Game is not the same as *Small Game Walk-in Access*. The Walk-in Access Program gives small game hunters the opportunity to purchase a \$20 permit in addition to the Small Game license that allows them to access 145,000 acres of private land. ANNUAL RESIDENT SENIOR FISHING LICENSE

The Annual Resident Senior Fishing License costs \$1.00. The cost covers Search and Rescue and PEAK. These licenses are available to customers 64 years of age or older.

TSL MACHINE MESSAGES/ACH

Keep in mind when pulling your ACH reports off of the TLS machine that often times there are messages or reminders with regard to insurance and or surety information. These are reminders to you to update your property insurance information or your surety. Proof of property insurance is necessary for the coverage of the TLS machine. The surety is necessary to cover the potential loss of revenue from the sales of licenses in the event an agent does not meet their financial obligation to the CDOW.

COLORADO WILDLIFE HABITAT STAMP REQUIREMENTS

Colorado Wildlife Habitat Stamp Requirements

For the License Buyer: A Colorado Wildlife Habitat Stamp is required for people ages 19-64 who buy hunting or fishing licenses. With a license purchase the stamp is \$5 and required on each of the first 2 licenses bought in a calendar year (\$10 total). This stamp also allows legal access to state wildlife areas (SWA) or state trust lands (STL) leased by the DOW.

For wildlife/outdoor enthusiasts: A Colorado Wildlife Habitat Stamp is required for people ages 19-64 who wish to access a SWA or STL (for instance, non-license holders recreating with license holders, wildlife viewers, or hikers). This stamp is \$10.25 (25 cent search and rescue fee included).

Lifetime Stamp: Anyone can purchase a Lifetime Habitat Stamp (\$200) which will satisfy either of the above requirements.
