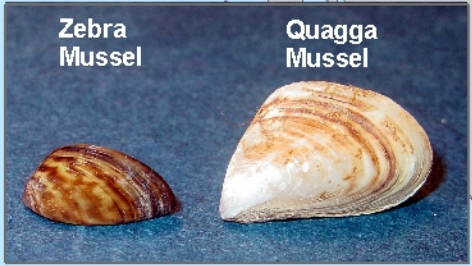
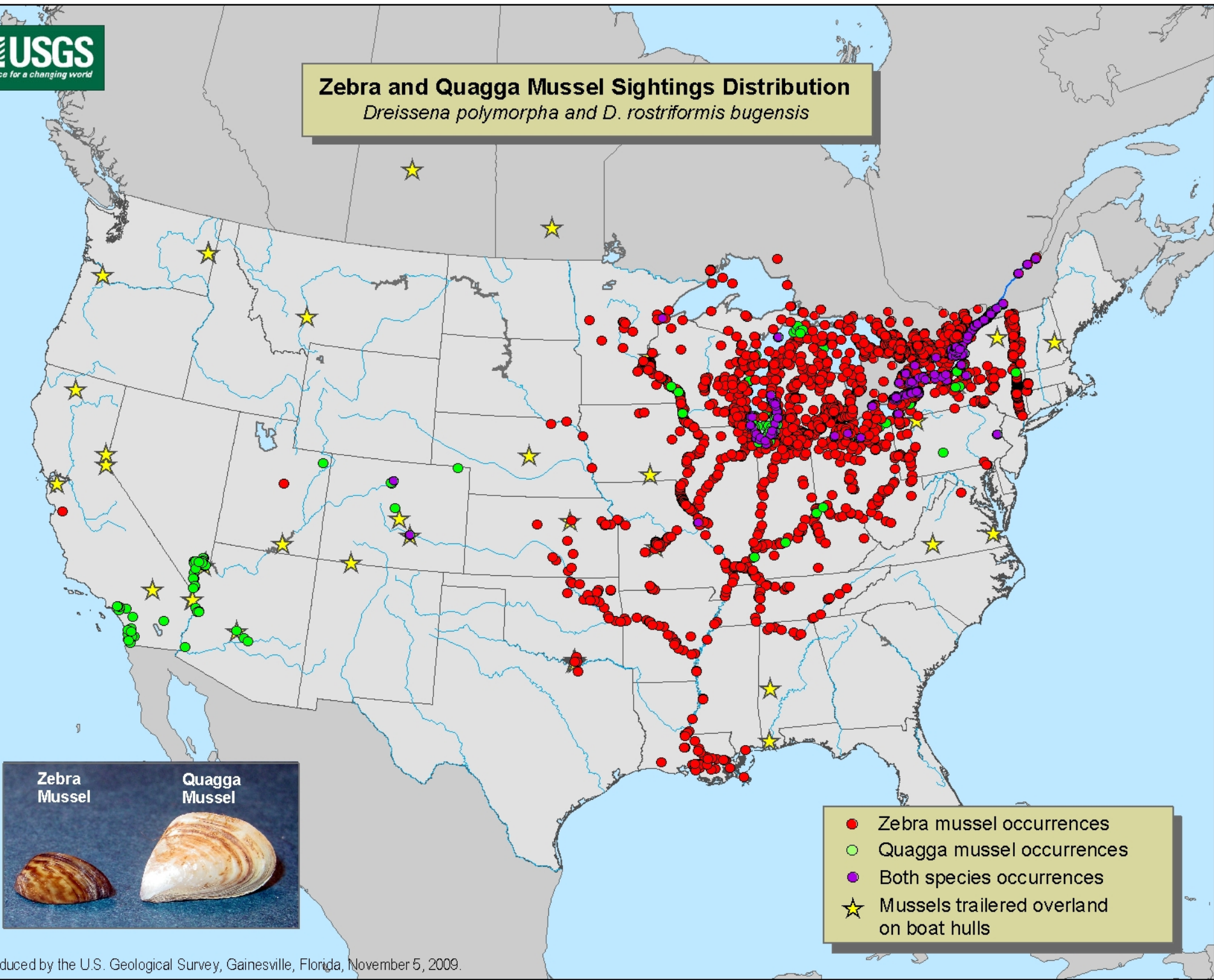


Zebra and Quagga Mussel Sightings Distribution
